A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 53 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, by amending section 603, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-120 and 7-118, for the purpose of raising the maximum amount in wages which may be taxed as contribution to Social Security, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- Section 1. Section 603 of title 53 of the Code of the 2 Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 3 5-120 and 7-118, is hereby further amended to read as follows: "Section 603. Definitions. In this chapter, unless the context otherwise 5 requires, the following definitions shall be 6 7 applicable: 8
 - (1)'Became disabled' means the first month in which an individual is under a disability and is both fully and currently insured.
 - 'Board' means the Federated States of (2) Micronesia Social Security Board provided for by section 701 of this subtitle.
 - (3) 'Child or spouse' means that an applicant is the child or spouse of an individual if the court of the State in which the individual was domiciled at the time of his death has or would find the applicant to be the individual's child or spouse in determining the devolution of intestate personal property.
 - 'Contributions' means the tax imposed upon income of covered employees and the tax imposed upon employers on account of wages paid to a covered employee.
- · (5) 'Disability' means inability to engage in 25

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any substantial gainful employment by reason of any 1 2 medically determinable physical or mental 3 impairment which can be expected to result in death or which has lasted or can be expected to last for a 4 continuous period of not less than twelve months. 5 'Earning test' means that an individual who receives a retirement, disability, or survivor 7 8 benefit and who works in covered or noncovered employment shall have his quarterly benefit reduced 9 by one dollar for each two dollars earned in a 10 quarter, except there shall be no reduction for the 11 first \$300 earned in a quarter. The reduction shall 12 13 be applied in one of the subsequent two quarters immediately after the quarter in which the earnings 14 were made, or as soon as possible thereafter. 15 (7) 'Employee' means: 16 (a) any officer of a corporation; or 17 any individual who, under the usual (b) 18 common law rules applicable in determining the 19 20 employer-employee relationship, has the status of an 21 employee; or any self-employed person who has at 22 (c) least one employee for whom he is required to report 23 in a given quarter; or 24

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any self-employed person who had more

1	than \$10,000 of annual gross revenue in the
2	preceding calendar year.
3	(8) 'Employment' means any service by an
4	employee for an employer incorporated or doing
5	business within the Federated States of Micronesia
6	employing him, irrespective of where such employment
7	is performed, except family employment.
8	(9) 'Family employment' means employment of a
9	worker by a member of the household, a parent or a
10	son or daughter except that the worker may apply to
11	the Board for a determination that such employment
12	is bona fide covered employment subject to this
13	subtitle.
14	(10) 'Insured status' can mean any of the
15	following:
16	(a) 'Currently insured individual' means
17	any individual who has had not less than eight
18	quarters of coverage during the 13-quarter period
19	ending with:
20	(i) the quarter in which he died; or
21	(ii) the quarter in which he became
22	entitled to old age insurance benefits; or
23	(iii) the quarter in which he became
24	disabled, whichever first occurs.
25	(b) 'Fully insured individual' means any

individual who has not less than one quarter of coverage for each year beginning after June 30, 1968, or for each year after attaining the age of twenty-one, whichever is later, and up to but excluding the year in which he attained retirement age, became disabled, or died, whichever first occurred, except that in no case shall an individual be a fully insured individual unless he has at least twelve quarters of coverage.

- · (11) 'Quarter' and 'calendar quarter' mean a period of three calendar months ending on March 31st, June 30th, September 30th, or December 31st. "Quarter of coverage" means a quarter in which the individual has been paid fifty dollars or more in wages in employment subject to this subtitle.
- (12) 'Wages' means remuneration paid subject to the provisions of this subtitle, including the cash value of all remuneration paid in any medium other than cash and remuneration accruing to a self-employed person. Remuneration accruing to a self-employed person shall be deemed to be twice the amount paid to the highest paid employee reported by the self-employed person in a quarter, \$31,000\$\frac{55,000}{000}\$ maximum per quarter. Remuneration accruing to a self-employed person who has no

1	covered employees shall, for each quarter of a year,
2	be deemed to be 2.5 percent of the gross revenue of
3	the business for the previous calendar year, subject
4	to $\$B//000\$55,000$ maximum. Remuneration paid for any
5	service which is more or less than a whole dollar
6	shall, as may be prescribed by regulations, be
7	computed to the nearest dollar. Wages shall not
8	include:
9	(a) that part of remuneration in excess
10	of $\$3/4/\$0/\%55.000$ paid in a quarterly reporting
11	period
12	by one employer;
13	(b) any payment on account of sickness or
14	accident disability, or medical or hospitalization
15	expenses made by an employer to or on behalf of an
16	employee;
17	(c) any payment made to or on behalf of
18	an employee or to the employee's beneficiary from a
19	trust or annuity;
20	(d) remuneration paid in any medium other
21	than cash to an employee for service not in the
22	course of the employer's trade or business or for
23	domestic service in a private home of an employer;
24	(e) remuneration paid for casual or
25	intermittent labor not performed in the course of

1	the employer's trade or business when such
2	employment does not exceed employment in more than
3	one week in each calendar month of each quarterly
4	reporting period; and
5	(f) remuneration from family employment
6	subject to the provisions of this subtitle."
7	Section 2. This act will take effect on October 1, 1997.
8	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by
9	the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
10	becoming law without such approval.
