## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 10-24, as amended by Public Law No. 10-32, by amending section 16, for the purpose of changing the allottees of funds appropriated for Rural Development (USDA) in the State of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 16 of Public Law No.10-24 is hereby

3		"Section 16. Allotment and management of funds and

5		shall be allotted, managed, administered, and
6		accounted for in accordance with applicable law,
7		including, but not limited to, the Financial

9		allottee of the funds under section 7 of this act

12		FURTHER that the funds appropriated to Chuuk State

14		shall be retained in the General Fund of the

16		recipient is identified to the President or the
17		President's designee, at which time scholarship
18		funds in the amount of the scholarship award shall
19		be disbursed directly to the educational
20		institution in the form of a two-party check
21		payable to both the scholarship recipient and the
22		educational institution he or she is attending; and
23		PROVIDED FURTHER, that the allottee for the funds
24		appropriated under subsection (2)(m)(ii) of section
25		11 of this act shall be Micronesian Legal Services

Corporation; and PROVIDED FURTHER, that the allottees for the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(o) of section 11 of this act shall be the Governors of the respective States, and no funds appropriated under subsection (2)(o) of section 11 of this act shall be disbursed from the General Fund to the allottees unless the President certifies that the State involved has entered into a joint law enforcement agreement for the period of October 1, 1997, to September 30, 1998, with the National Government pursuant to chapter 12 of /thé title 12 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia; and PROVIDED FURTHER, that the allottees for the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(s) of section 11 of this act shall be the Chief Justices of the respective States; and PROVIDED FURTHER, that the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(hh)(iii)a) of section 11 of this act shall be the executive director of the Chuuk Housing Authority; and PROVIDED FURTHER, that the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(hh)(iii)b) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State; and PROVIDED FURTHER, that the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(ii) of section 11
