## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, by amending section 224, as renumbered by Public Law No. 9-074, to set forth circumstances under which funds may be disbursed in advance of obligation, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Section 1. Section 224 of title 55 of the Code of the
2	Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, and as renumbered
3	by Public Law No. 9-076, is hereby amended to read as
4	follows:
5	"Section 224. <u>Disbursement procedures</u> .
6	Unless otherwise specifically provided by law, the
7	following procedures shall control the
8	administration and management of all funds
9	appropriated from the General Fund of the
10	Federated States of Micronesia or made available
11	to the Federated States of Micronesia from other
12	sources:
13	(1) All such funds shall remain in the
14	custody and control of the Secretary of Finance
15	until they are obligated and disbursed by him in
16	accordance with law, provided, however that the
17	Secretary may disburse funds in advance of
18	obligation, in accordance with regulations, as
19	follows:
20	(a) for travel;
21	(b) for advances against individual
22	salaries or wages, which shall not exceed the
23	amount earned by the employee or official but not
24	yet paid;.
25	(c) for the purchase of personal

1	property for which a Purchase Order, Job Order, or
2	Request has been processed with the Secretary;
3	(d) to advance funds under a contract
4	to which an FSM National Government branch or
5	agency is a party, when required by the terms of
6	the contract; and
7	(e) to establish a petty cash fund of
8	no more than \$200 for incidental expenses.
9	(2) Such funds shall be deemed to be
10	obligated as of the date the person or entity to
11	whom the funds are allotted enters into a legally
12	binding written agreement supported by the
13	documentary evidence required by section 218 219
14	of this chapter or rules and regulations issued
15	pursuant to authority vested by section 227 228 of
16	this chapter.
17	(3) The Secretary of Finance shall disburse
18	such funds as may be required to liquidate valid
19	obligations within 30 days of their becoming
20	payable, as indicated by valid documentary
21	evidence of such obligation and a valid claim for
22	payment, if required by the terms of the document
23	evidencing the obligation."
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Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such approval. Date: 2-09-98 Introduced by: Resio S. Moses
