A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 8-75, as amended, by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79, 8-116, 8-145, 9-013, 9-065, 9-119, and 10-77, to specify that the poultry project funded therein for the State of Kosrae shall be a state project, by further amending section 3, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79, 8-116, 8-145, 8-149, 9-004, 9-013, 9-055, 9-065, 9-119, 10-48, and 10-77, for the purpose of making the Kosrae State Governor the allottee of said funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

16 Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 8-75, as amended by Public Laws Nos.
 17 8-79, 8-116, 8-145, 8-149, 9-004, 9-013, 9-055, 9-065, 9-119, 10-48, and
 18 10-77, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

19 "Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed,
 20 administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable law,
 21 including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
 22 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (1)(a) of section 2
 23 of this act shall be the PWP Development Authority, except that the
 24 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (1)(a)(iv)c),
 25 (1)(a)(v) and (1)(a)(vi) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of

1 Polle Municipality. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
2 subsections (1)(b)(i), (1)(b)(ii), (1)(b)(iii) and (1)(b)(iv) of
3 section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of Fono. The allottee of the funds
4 appropriated under subsections (1)(b)(v), (1)(b)(vi) and
5 (1)(b)(vii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of Pis-Paneu.
6 The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(b)(viii),
7 (1)(b)(x), (1)(b)(xi), and (1)(b)(xvii) of section 2 of this act shall
8 be the Mayor of Weno. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
9 subsections (1)(b)(ix), (1)(b)(xii), (1)(b)(xiii), (1)(b)(xiv),
10 (1)(b)(xv), (1)(b)(xvi), and (1)(b)(xviii) of section 2 of this act
11 shall be the Weno Projects Coordinator. The allottee of the funds
12 appropriated under subsection (1)(c) of section 2 of this act shall be
13 the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The allottee of the funds
14 appropriated under subsection (1)(d) of section 2 of this act shall be
15 the Lower Mortlocks Development Authority. The allottee of the funds
16 appropriated under subsection (1)(e)(i) and (1)(e)(ii) of section 2 of
17 this act shall be the Executive Director of the Hall Development
18 Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
19 (1)(e)(iii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Pattiw Development
20 Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections
21 (1)(e)(iv), (1)(e)(v) and (1)(e)(vi) of section 2 of this act shall be
22 the Weito Development Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated
23 under subsections (1)(e)(vii), (1)(e)(viii), (1)(e)(ix), (1)(e)(x),
24 (1)(e)(xi)a), (1)(e)(xi)c) (1)(e)(xii), and (1)(e)(xiii) of section
25 2 of this act shall be the Pattiw Development Authority. The allottee of

1 the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(e)(xi)b) of section 2 of
2 this act shall be the Director of Public Safety for the State of Chuuk. The
3 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (1)(e)(xiv) of
4 section 2 of this act shall be the Namonweitto Project Coordinator. The
5 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(f)(i),
6 (1)(f)(ii) and (1)(f)(vi) of section 2 of this act shall be the Executive
7 Director of COCA. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
8 subsection (1)(f)(iii), (1)(f)(iv) and (1)(f)(v) of section 2 of this
9 act shall be the Governor of the State of Chuuk. The allottee of the funds
10 appropriated under subsection (1)(f)(vii) of section 2 of this act shall
11 be the Lower Mortlocks Development Authority. The allottee of the funds
12 appropriated under subsection (2)(a)(i) of section 2 of this act shall be
13 the Luhkenkolwof of Sapwuafik. The allottee of the funds appropriated
14 under subsection (2)(a)(ii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Chief
15 Magistrate of Nukuoro. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
16 subsection (2)(a)(iii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Chief
17 Magistrate of Kapingamarangi. The allottee of the funds appropriated
18 under subsection (2)(a)(iv) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor
19 of Kolonia Town. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
20 subsections (2)(a)(v)a), (2)(a)(v)b) and 2(a)(v)i) of section 2 of
21 this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of Sokehs. The allottee of the funds
22 appropriated under subsections (2)(c)(i), (2)(c)(iii), (2)(e),
23 (2)(f), (4)(b), (4)(c), (4)(d), (4)(e), (4)(f), (4)(g), ~~(4)(h)~~,
24 (4)(i), (4)(j) and (4)(k) of section 2 of this act shall be the
25 President of the Federated States of Micronesia. The allottee of the funds

1 appropriated under subsections (2)(a)(v)c) of section 2 of this act
2 shall be the Pohnpei Utilities Corporation. The allottee of the funds
3 appropriated under subsection (2)(b) of section 2 of this act shall be
4 the Vice President of the Federated States of Micronesia or the Vice
5 President's designee. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
6 subsections (2)(c)(ii) and (2)(d) of section 2 of this act shall be the
7 Pohnpei Transportation Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated
8 under subsection 3 of section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of the
9 State of Yap or his designee. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
10 subsection (4)(a) of section 2 of this act shall be the Chairman of the
11 Kosrae Sports Council. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
12 subsections (4)(l) and (4)(n) of section 2 of this act shall be the
13 Mayor of the Lelu Municipal Government. The allottee of the funds
14 appropriated under subsections (4)(m) and (4)(o) of section 2 of this
15 act shall be the Mayor of the Malem Municipal Government. The allottee
16 of the funds appropriated under subsection (4)(p) of section 2 of this
17 act shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia. The
18 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (4)(q) of section 2
19 of this act shall be the Mayor of the Tafunsak Municipal Government.
20 The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so
21 much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose
22 specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the
23 sum appropriated. Notwithstanding Public Law No. 9-040, the
24 authority of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall
25 not lapse."
