A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 10-24, as amended, by further amending section 11, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 10-32, 10-56, and 10-87, to modify the use of certain funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Section 1. Section 11 of Public Law No. 10-24, as amended by Public
2	Laws Nos. 10-32, 10-56, and 10-87, is hereby further amended to read as
3	follows:
4	"Section 11. Other National Government programs, grants, subsidies,
5	contributions, and refunds. The sum of \$4,286,168, or so much
6	thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
7	General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year
8	ending September 30, 1998, for special programs, grants, subsidies,
9	contributions, and refunds of the National Government of the
10	Federated States of Micronesia during fiscal year 1998. The sum
11	appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as follows:
