A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 10-24, as amended, by further amending section 1, as amended by Public Law No. 10-87, and by amending sections 5 and 13, to appropriate the sum of \$737,220 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1998, as supplemental funding for the National Executive Branch and the Development budget, and to reprogram certain funds already appropriated, and by amending section 15, to permit unlimited reprogramming into the recruitment and repatriation line, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 10-24, as amended by 1 Public Law No. 10-87, is hereby further amended to read as follows: 2 3 "Section 1. Operating expenses of the Executive Branch. The sum of \$121,1301,1134 12,967,954, or so much thereof as 4 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal 6 year ending September 30, 1998, for the operations of the 8 Executive Branch of the National Government of the Federated 9 States of Micronesia during fiscal year 1998.
