A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 50 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-54, 5-105, 7-23, 7-38 and 10-14, by further amending section 115, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 7-38 and 10-14, to require any aircraft or sea vessel entering the Federated States of Micronesia whose activities require services to be performed by quarantine officials at times outside of ordinary working hours to pay for the overtime costs of the affected government officials, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 115 of Title 50 of the Code of the 1 Federated States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as 2 3 follows: "Section 115. Aircraft and sea vessel 4 responsibility for overtime. Any aircraft or sea 5 vessel landing at any airport or calling at any port 6 in the Federated States of Micronesia shall be 7 responsible for paying to the treasurer of the 8 Federated States of Micronesia an amount equal to 9 the actual costs to the National Government for 10 overtime accrued by the officials responsible for 11 carrying out the purposes of this title, [and] 12 chapter 2 of title 54 and chapter 4 of title 22 13 whenever such officials are required to carry out 14 their official duties relating to the aircraft or 15 sea vessel at a time outside of the official's 16 ordinary working hours. The Secretary of Finance 17 shall determine the amount payable by the aircraft 18 or sea vessel under this section and shall submit 19 invoices to the aircraft or sea vessel for payment 20 of such amounts on a monthly basis; PROVIDED, 21 however, in the case an aircraft or sea vessel's 22 arrival is for one time only or is likely to occur 23 at in frequent intervals the invoice shall be made 24 as soon as possible after the arrival of the vessel 25

1	or aircraft, including at the time of arrival itself
2	as may be provided for by regulations. For purposes
3	of this section, overtime means actual hours worked
	in excess of 40 actual hours per week worked by an
4	
5	official or employee of the National Government."
6	Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the
7	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
8	becoming law without such approval.
