A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 9-100, as amended, by further amending section 1, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 9-104, 9-129, 9-150, 10-1 and 10-116, to modify the purpose for which certain funds were appropriated for the State of Chuuk, and by further amending section 5, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 9-104, 9-137, 9-151, 10-20, 10-44, 10-73, 10-116 and 10-117, to change the allottee of certain funds for public projects in the State of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 9-100, as amended by Public Laws
2 Nos. 9-104, 9-129, 9-150, 10-1 and 10-116, is hereby further amended to read as
3 follows:

4 "Section 1. The sum of \$5,350,000, or so much thereof as may
5 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of
6 the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
7 September 30, 1997, for the purpose of funding the
8 infrastructure, social and economic development and other
9 needs of the State of Chuuk. The funds appropriated by this
10 section shall be apportioned as follows:

5 Section 2. Section 5 of Public Law No. 9-100, as amended by Public Laws
6 Nos. 9-104, 9-137, 9-151, 10-20, 10-44, 10-73, 10-116 and 10-117, is hereby
7 further amended to read as follows:

8 "Section 5. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
9 managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with
10 applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management
11 Act of 1979. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
12 subsection (1)(e) of section 1 of this act shall be the Secretary of
13 the Department of Health, Education and Social Affairs of the
14 Federated States of Micronesia, or his designee. The allottee of the
15 remaining funds appropriated under subsection (1) of section 1 of
16 this act shall be the Governor of the State of Chuuk. The allottee of
17 the funds appropriated under subsections (2)(a), (2)(b), (2)(c) and
18 (2)(d) of section 1 of this act shall be the Toleisom Authority. The
19 allottees of the funds appropriated under subsections (2)(e) and
20 (2)(f), except for funds appropriated under subsections (2)(e)(iv)
21 and (2)(f)(iv), of section 1 of this act shall be the mayors of the
22 respective municipalities. The allottee of the funds appropriated
23 under subsections (2)(e)(iv), (2)(f)(iv), (2)(g), (2)(h) and (2)(i) of
24 section 1 of this act shall be the mayor of Polle Municipality. The
25 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (3) of section 1

1 be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The allottee of
2 the funds appropriated under subsections (4) and (8) of section 1 of
3 this act shall be the Northern Namoneas Development Authority. The
4 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (5) of section 1
5 of this act shall be the Mortlock Development Authority. The allottee
6 of the funds appropriated under subsection (6)(a) of section 1 of
7 this act shall be the Halls Project Coordinator. The allottee of the
8 funds appropriated under subsection (6)(b) of section 1 of this act
9 shall be the Weito Project Coordinator. The allottee of the funds
10 appropriated under subsections (6)(c) and (6)(d) of section 1 of
11 this act shall be the Pattiw Development Authority. The allottee of
12 the funds appropriated under subsection (6)(e) of section 1 of this
13 act shall be the Northwest Islands Project Coordinator. The allottee
14 of the funds appropriated under subsection (7) of section 1 of this
15 act shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of
16 Micronesia or the Speaker's designee. The allottee of the funds
17 appropriated under subsection (2) of section 2 of this act shall be
18 the Chairman of the Kosrae Utilities Authority, and the allottee of the
19 funds appropriated under subsection (9) of section 2 of this act shall
20 be the Governor of the State of Kosrae. The allottee of the funds
21 appropriated under subsection (1)(a)(i) of section 3 of this act shall
22 be the Mayor of Kolonia Town. The allottee of the funds
23 appropriated under subsections (1)(a)(ii)a), (1)(a)(ii)b), and
24 (1)(a)(ii)c) of section 3 of this act shall be the Pohnpei
25 Transportation Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated

of the funds appropriated under subsection (1)(a)(ii)d) of section 3 of this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of Sokehs Municipality. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (1)(b) of section 3 of this act shall be the Vice President of the Federated States of Micronesia or the Vice President's designee. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (2)(a) and (2)(b) of section 3 of this act shall be the Pohnpei Visitor's Bureau. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (1) and (3) of section 4 of this act shall be the Governor of the State of Yap. The allottee of all other funds appropriated by this act shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or the President's designee. The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottees of the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(a) and (1)(b) of section 3 of this act shall not obligate any funds appropriated therein without first consulting with the member of the Pohnpei Delegation to Congress representing the Election District to which the funds are apportioned. The allottees of funds appropriated under subsection (1)(a) of section 3 of this act shall not obligate or expend any funds apportioned under said subsection for travel. The authority of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall not lapse."

1 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the
2 Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such approval.
