A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 10-120, as amended by Public Law No. 10-122, by further amending section 3, as amended by Public Law No. 10-122, and to amend Public Law No. 10-126, by amending section 3, for the purpose of reprogramming funding from the latter public law to the former, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 10-120, as amended by
2	Public Law No. 10-122, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
3	"Section 3. The sum of $\{3,000,000\}$ $3,109,625$, or so
4	much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated
5	from the General Fund of the Federated States of
6	Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1999,
7	for the purpose of funding infrastructure and other
8	projects and programs in the State of Pohnpei."
9	Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 10-126 is hereby
10	amended to read as follows:
11	"Section 3. The sum of $\{650,750\}$ $541,125$, or so much
12	thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from
13	the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia
14	for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1999, for the
15	purpose of funding health, education, infrastructure and
16	other public projects and programs in the State of
17	Pohnpei. The funds appropriated under subsection (1) of
18	this section shall be deemed to come from the
19	communication operations and maintenance account, section
20	215(a)(2) of the Compact of Free Association. The funds
21	appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:
22	(1) Department of Public Safety, Pohnpei State -
23	communication equipment\$ 50,750

25	and other public projects and programs $[600,000]$ $490,375$
