A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 8-75, as amended, by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79, 8-116, 8-145, 9-013, 9-065, 9-119, 10-77 and 10-111, to reinstate funds inadvertently omitted in Public Law No. 10-111, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
