

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend and restate Public Law No. 12-50 to appropriate an additional sum of \$9,844,601, for a total of \$36,045,435, from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2003, for the purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions; to establish a budget for compact sections 211, 214(b), 215(a)(2), 215(b)(2), 216(a)(1), 216(a)(2), 216(a)(3), 216(b), and 221(b); to establish a capital and human resource development budget and appropriate funds available therefor; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 12-50 is hereby
2 restated to read as follows:

3 "Section 1. Definitions.

4 (1) "Budget book" means the document entitled
5 Federated States of Micronesia National Government
6 Fiscal Year 2003 Proposed Budget transmitted by the
7 President to the Speaker of the Congress of the
8 Federated States of Micronesia on March 25, 2002.

9 (2) "Activity" means that set of activities set
10 forth in the performance budget pages of the budget book
11 for each department, office, agency or program. An
12 activity is a general policy objective, the achievement
13 of which can be measured. An activity is part of a
14 strategic goal and will result in a certain amount or

1 number of outputs or units of work.

2 (3) "Performance budget pages" means those pages in
3 the budget book that set forth the strategic goals,
4 activities, objectives and outputs for each department
5 or agency.

6 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 12-50 is hereby

 24 which funding is either increased or decreased.

25 Reprogramming to increase employees' salaries shall not

1 be permitted unless authorized by law. Funds that are
2 appropriated under section 2 of this act and apportioned
3 to a department or office under subsections 2(1) through
4 2(8) of this act shall not be reprogrammed to or from
5 such department or office."

6 Section 16. Section 16 of Public Law No. 12-50 is hereby
7 amended as to read as follows:

8 "Section 16. Allotment and management of funds and
9 lapse date.

10 (1) *General Provisions.*

11 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
12 allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in
13 accordance with applicable law, including, but not
14 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979;

15 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for
16 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
17 necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in
18 this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
19 of the sum appropriated.

20 (2) *Allottees.* The allottees of the funds
21 appropriated by this act are as follows:

22 (a) section 2 - the allottee of these funds
23 shall be the President of the Federated States of
24 Micronesia;

25 (b) section 3 - the allottee of these funds

1 shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated
2 States of Micronesia;

3 (c) section 4 - the allottee of these funds
4 shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the
5 Federated States of Micronesia;

6 (d) section 5 - the allottee of these funds
7 shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of
8 Micronesia;

9 (e) section 6 through 13 - the allottee of
10 these funds shall be the President of the Federated
11 States of Micronesia; EXCEPT THAT for the following
12 subsections of section 6 through 13 of this act, the
13 allottees shall be:

14 (i) section 8, subsection (5) - the
15 allottee of these funds shall be the President of the
16 Federated States of Micronesia;

17 (ii) section 8, subsection (8)(a) through
18 (8)(d) - the allottee of these funds shall be Chief
19 Justice of the respective state;

20 (iii) section 13, subsection (1)(a) through
21 (1)(d) - the allottee of these funds shall be the
22 President of the College of Micronesia-FSM;

23 (iv) section 13, subsection (2)(a) through
24 (2)(d) - the allottee of these funds shall be the
25 Governor of the respective state, EXCEPT THAT the

1 allottee for funds allocated to Chuuk State under
2 subsection (2)(c) shall be the President of the
3 Federated States of Micronesia; and

4 (v) Section 13, subsection (15) - the
5 allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of
6 the Supreme Court of the Federated States of Micronesia.

7 (3) *Lapse Dates*. The authority of the allottees to
8 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as
9 of September 30, 2003, EXCEPT that funds appropriated
10 under section 13 of this act shall not lapse."
11

12 Section 17. This act shall become law upon approval by the
13 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
14 becoming law without such approval.
