I am pleased to inform you that I have designated the following Congressional Act as Public Law No. 15-18:

Congressional Act No. 15-27 "AN ACT TO AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 15-11, BY AMENDING SECTIONS 1, 2, 8, AND 9 THEREOF, IN ORDER TO APPROPRIATE AN ADDITIONAL \$1,410,600 FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR [THE] FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2008, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."


I want to express my sincere appreciation for two appropriations in particular, the \$750,000 for dry docking of the Caroline Voyager and the \$525,600 to the FSM Petroleum Corporation to establish a reserve account with the Bank of Guam. Several of my requests were deferred, and I look forward to taking up those matters during the January 2008 session, in accordance with Standing Committee Report No. 15-54.

I must tell you that the \$40,000 appropriation for outstanding obligations of the Washington, D.C. embassy gives me pause. To begin, there are no details in the Committee Report or the text of C.A. No. 15-27 to support and clarify this appropriation for the embassy. It is also troubling in light of the well known *Udot* case, in light of recent incidences of financial management lapses at this particular embassy and in light of the Congress's view that some of my requests were not supported by cost breakdowns. I recognize that there are certain embassy obligations that must be paid; however, given the vagueness of this \$40,000 appropriation, I want to put the Congress on notice that under my direction, no funds will be released from the General Fund for this appropriation until every claim for payment is reviewed and verified by the Department of Finance and Administration.

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 15-11, by amending sections 1, 2, 8, and 9 thereof, in order to appropriate an additional \$1,410,600 from the General Fund for fiscal year ending September 30, 2008, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The title of Public Law No. 15-11 is hereby
2 amended to read as follows:

3 “To appropriate the sum of \$39,178,699 from the General
4 Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the
