PUBLIC LAW No. 15-39

AN ACT

To further amend title 41 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, by enacting a new chapter 11 thereof, to establish a Cancer Registry System in the Federated States of Micronesia for the collection of information on the incidence of cancer and related data; to provide for the confidentiality of identifying information regarding cancer patients, health care facilities and health care providers; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Title 41 of the Code of the Federated States of
- 2 Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by enacting a
- 3 new chapter 11 entitled "Cancer Registry System Act".
- 4 Section 2. Title 41 of the Code of the Federated States of
- 5 Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding a new
- 6 section 1101 of chapter 11 to read as follows:
- 7 "Section 1101. Short title. This chapter shall be known
- 8 and cited as the 'Cancer Registry System Act'."
- 9 Section 3. Title 41 of the Code of the Federated States of
- 10 Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding a new
- 11 section 1102 of chapter 11 to read as follows:
- "Section 1102. Definitions.
- 13 As used in this chapter, the following terms shall have
- 14 the following meanings set forth below:
- 15 (1) "Cancer" means all malignant neoplasms,
- 16 regardless of the tissue of origin, including malignant

1	lymphoma disease and all benigh brain tumors.
2	(2) "Health care facility" means a hospital, nursing
3	home, clinic, community health center, dispensary,
4	office or other institution that provides medical care
5	in the Federated States of Micronesia
6	(3) "Health care provider" means a physician (M.D.,
7	M.B.B.S., M.O., D.O., or D.D.S), medex, nurse
8	practitioner, registered nurse, graduate nurse, nurse
9	midwife, practical nurse and/or health assistant in the
LO	Federated States of Micronesia.
1	(4) "Secretary" means the Secretary of Health,
.2	Education and Social Affairs (HESA) or person designated
13	by the Secretary to compile information, prepare
4	reports, or perform any functions required or permitted
15	under this Act."
.6	Section 3. Title 41 of the Code of the Federated States of
.7	Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding a new
8.	section 1103 of chapter 11 to read as follows:
.9	"Section 1103. <u>Cancer Registry</u> .
20	(1) The Secretary and each health facility and health
21	care provider shall jointly establish a uniform, nation-
22	wide population-based cancer registry system for the
23	collection of information regarding the incidence of
24	cancer and related data. The Secretary and each health
5	care facility and health care provider shall jointly

adopt rules necessary to effect the purposes of this 2 Act, including the data to be reported and the effective date after which reporting by health care facilities and 3 health care providers' shall be required. 4 (2) The Secretary shall establish a training program 5 for the personnel of participating health care 6 facilities and a quality control program for cancer 7 The Secretary shall collaborate in studies with 8 clinicians and epidemiologists and publish reports on 9 the results of such studies. The Secretary shall 10 11 cooperate with the U.S. National Institutes of Health and the Centers for Disease Control in providing cancer 12 incidence data." 13 Section 4. Title 41 of the Code of the Federated States of 14 Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding a new 15 section 1104 of chapter 11 to read as follows: 16 17 "Section 1104. Participation in program. Each health care facility and health care provider 18 19 diagnosing or providing treatment to cancer patients 20 shall report to the Secretary each cancer case that occurs within that facility or provider's office. 21 22 Within 120 days of the effective date of this Act, the Secretary and each health care provider and health care 23 facility shall jointly promulgate a plan to set forth 24 the format, content and timing of the report required by 25

1	this section, including remedies and penalties for non-
2	compliance. Any cancer patient whose diagnosis or
3	treatment is reported to the Secretary shall be informed
4	of this fact by the health care facility or health care
5	provider prior to submission of the report. This
6	section shall only apply to cancer cases diagnosed or
7	treated following the effective date of this Act."
8	Section 5. Title 41 of the Code of the Federated States of
9	Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding a new
10	section 1105 of chapter 11 to read as follows:
11	"Section 1105. Confidentiality.
12	(1) All information reported pursuant to this Act
13	shall be confidential and privileged. The Secretary
14	shall take strict measures to ensure that all
15	identifying information is kept confidential.
16	(2) All identifying information regarding an
17	individual patient, health care provider or health care
18	facility contained in records of interviews, written
19	reports, letters or statements procured by the
20	Secretary, or by any other person, agency or
21	organization acting jointly with the Secretary, in
22	connection with cancer morbidity and mortality studies
23	shall be confidential and privileged and may be used
24	solely for the purposes of the study. Nothing in this

1	statistical compilations relating to morbidity and
2	mortality studies, which do not identify individual
3	cases or sources of information."
4	Section 6. Title 41 of the Code of the Federated States of
5	Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding a new
6	section 1106 of chapter 11 to read as follows:
7	"Section 1106. <u>Disclosure</u> .
8	(1) The Secretary may enter into agreements to
9	exchange confidential information with other cancer
10	registries or health care facilities in order to obtain
11	complete reports of FSM residents diagnosed or treated
12	in other countries, or subdivisions thereof, and to
13	provide information to other countries, and subdivisions
14	thereof, regarding their residents diagnosed or treated
15	in the FSM.
16	(2) The Secretary may furnish statistical information
17	to other nations' cancer registries, cancer control
18	agencies, or health researchers in order to collaborate
19	in a national or regional cancer registry or to
20	collaborate in cancer control and prevention research
21	studies. Before releasing confidential information, the
22	Secretary shall first obtain evidence of the approval of
23	his or her academic committee for the protection of
24	human subjects or the equivalent."
25	Section 7. Title 41 of the Code of the Federated States of

1	Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding a new
2	section 1107 of chapter 11 to read as follows:
3	"Section 1107. Liability.
4	(1) No action for damages arising from the disclosure
5	of confidential or privileged information may be
6	maintained against any person, or the employer or
7	employee of any person, who participates in good faith
8	in the reporting of cancer registry data or data for
9	cancer morbidity or mortality studies in accordance with
LO	this Act.
L1	(2) No license of a health care facility or health
L2	care provider may be denied, suspended or revoked for
L3	the good faith disclosure of confidential or privileged
4	information in the reporting of cancer registry data for
15	cancer morbidity or mortality studies in accordance with
.6	this Act.
.7	(3) Nothing in this section shall be construed to
.8	apply to the unauthorized disclosure of confidential or
.9	privileged information when such disclosure is due to
20	gross negligence or willful misconduct."
21	Section 8. Title 41 of the Code of the Federated States of
2	Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding a new
23	section 1108 of chapter 11 to read as follows:
24	"Section 1108. Penalties for unauthorized
5	digglogues of gonfidential information

1	(1) Any person who discloses confidential information
2	obtained for the purposes of this Chapter, except in
3	accordance with this Chapter, shall be guilty of an
4	offense and shall be liable on conviction in a court of
5	law to a fine of \$2,000 or to imprisonment for not more
6	than six months, or to both such fine and imprisonment.
7	Section 9. Effective date. This Act shall take effect upon
8	its approval by the President, or upon its becoming law without
9	such approval, except as otherwise provided by law.
