
I am pleased to inform you that I have designated the following Congressional Act as Public Law No 16-20:

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 16-07 to appropriate the "FSM Education Sector Grant - Fiscal Year 2010 - Amendment 1" grant of \$603,240 to the National Department of Education, to appropriate the "FSM Supplemental Education Grant - Fiscal Year 2009" grant of \$684,564 to the College of Micronesia - FSM, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 16-07, is hereby
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 1. The title of this act is as follows: To
4 appropriate the sum of \$36,566,779 from the General Fund
5 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
6 year ending September 30, 2010, for the purpose of
7 funding the operations of all branches of the National
8 Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its
9 agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and
10 contributions; and for other purposes. Of the total
11 amount of funds appropriated herein, \$4,403,240 shall be
12 deemed to come from funds available under the FSM
13 Education Grant - Fiscal Year 2010 - Amendment 1;
14 \$684,564 shall be deemed to come from funds available
15 under the FSM Supplemental Education Grant - Fiscal Year
16 2009; \$845,333 shall be deemed to come from funds
17 available under the FSM Health Sector Grant - Fiscal
18 Year 2010; \$384,107 shall be deemed to come from funds
19 available under the FSM Public Sector Capacity Building

1 Sector Grant – Fiscal Year 2010; \$-0- shall be deemed to
2 come from funds available under the FSM Private Sector
3 Development Sector Grant – Fiscal Year 2010; and \$-0-
4 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the
5 FSM Infrastructure Grant – Fiscal Year 2010. The sum
6 appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:"

7 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 16-07, is hereby
8 amended to read as follows:

9 "Section 2. Operating expenses of the Executive Branch.

10 The sum of \$15,468,090 or so much thereof as may be
11 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
12 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
13 year ending September 30, 2010, for the purpose of
14 funding the operations of the Executive Branch of the
15 National Government during the fiscal year 2010. Of the
16 total amount of funds appropriated herein, \$603,240
17 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the
18 FSM Education Sector Grant – Fiscal Year 2010 –
19 Amendment 1; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds
20 available under the FSM Supplemental Education Grant –
21 Fiscal Year 2009; \$645,333 shall be deemed to come from
22 funds available under the FSM Health Sector Grant –
23 Fiscal Year 2010; and \$81,750 shall be deemed to come
24 from funds available under the Public Sector Capacity
25 Building Sector Grant – Fiscal Year 2010. The sum

appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as follows:
