I transmit the following Congressional Act, which has become Public Law No. 16-41:

Congressional Act No. 16-49, "AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND SECTION 8 OF PUBLIC LAW NO. 16-7, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAWS NOS. 16-25, AND 16-35, TO MODIFY THE USE OF A LINE ITEM FOR THE OFFICE OF ENVIRONMENT AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

The law appropriates no additional fund beside the \$10,000 already appropriated. Rather it merely changes the law to authorize additional uses of the funds; therefore, I have approved it.

AN ACT

To further amend section 8 of Public Law No. 16-7, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 16-25, and 16-35, to modify the use of a line item for the Office of Environment and Emergency Management, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA.

1	Section 1. Section 8 of Public Law No. 16-7, as amended by
2	Public Law Nos. 16-25 and 16-35, is hereby further amended to
