AN ACT

To appropriate \$35,278,975 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, to provide funding for the operations of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The title of this act is as follows: To
2 appropriate the sum of \$35,278,975 from the General Fund of the
3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
4 September 30, 2010, for the purpose of funding the operations of
5 all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of
6 Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and
7 contributions; and for other purposes. Of the total amount of
8 funds appropriated herein, \$3,800,000 shall be deemed to come from
9 funds available under the amended Compact from education sector;
10 \$0 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the
11 Supplemental Education Grant; \$845,333 shall be deemed to come
12 from funds available under the amended Compact from health sector;
13 \$384,107 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the
14 amended Compact from capacity building sector; \$-0- shall be
15 deemed to come from funds available under the amended Compact from
16 private sector development; and \$-0- shall be deemed to come from
17 funds available under the amended Compact from infrastructure
18 sector. The sum appropriated herein shall be apportioned as

20 Section 11. Reprogramming. Reprogramming of funds into or

20 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for

13 Micronesia, EXCEPT THAT for the following subsections of sections
14 8 through 9 of this act:

15 (i) Section 8 subsection (13)(a) through
16 (d) - the allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of
17 the respective State Supreme Court,

18 (ii) section 9(1)(a) through (b) - the allottee of the fund shall
19 be the President of the College of Micronesia-FSM.

20 (3) Lapse Date. The authority of the allottee to
21 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of
22 September 30, 2010, EXCEPT the funds appropriated under section 9
23 of this act shall not lapse.
