Dear Speaker Figir:

This bill translates need of supplemental funding for governmental operations and obligation for Fiscal Year 2011. I note that one item requested by Executive branch is excluded and the rest were included but with substantial reduction. Nonetheless, I understand that adjustment was necessary to accommodate congressional operational needs.


Please note that there is a typographical error under Section 2 of the bill, particularly the figures reflecting total amount for operating expenses of the executive branch. C. A. No. 17-01 indicated a sum of \$17,227,380 but the correct amount should have been \$17,227,830. I am certain that all this requires is cosmetic correction.

In light of the urgent need of supplemental funding for this fiscal year, I am pleased to approve Congressional Act No. 17-01 and transmit it back as **Public Law No. 17-01**:

Congressional Act 17-01 "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FROM THE GENERAL FUND OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$400,000 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2011, BY AMENDING SECTIONS 1, 2, 3, AND 8 OF PUBLIC LAW NO. 16-43, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAWS NOS. 16-48, 16-53, 16-60, 16-65 AND 16-70, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

AN ACT

To appropriate from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia supplemental funding in the total amount of \$400,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2011, by amending sections 1, 2, 3, and 8 of Public Law No. 16-43, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 16-48, 16-53, 16-60, 16-65 and 16-70, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 16-43, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 16-48, 16-53, 16-60 and 16-65, is hereby
3 further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to
5 appropriate the sum of \$40,926,846 or so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, from the General Fund of the
7 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year
8 ending September 30, 2011, for the purpose of funding
9 the operations of all branches of the National
10 Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its
11 agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and
12 contributions. Of the total amount of funds
13 appropriated herein, \$4,403,240 shall be deemed to
14 come from funds available under the amended Compact
15 from the education sector; \$1,178,720 shall be deemed
16 to come from funds available under the Supplemental
17 Education Grant; \$868,276 shall be deemed to come
18 from funds available under the amended Compact from the

3 capacity building sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to
4 come from funds available under the amended Compact
5 from the private sector development sector; and \$-0-
6 shall be deemed to come from funds available under
7 the amended Compact from the infrastructure sector."

8 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 16-43, as amended
9 by Public Law Nos. 16-48, 16-53, 16-60 and 16-65 is hereby
10 further amended to read as follows:

11 "Section 2. Operating expenses of the Executive
12 Branch. The sum of \$17,227,380 or so much thereof as
13 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
14 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia
15 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2011, for
16 the purpose of funding the operations of the
17 Executive Branch of the National Government during
18 fiscal year 2011. Of the total amount of funds
19 appropriated herein, \$486,729 shall be deemed to come
20 from funds available under the amended Compact from
21 the education sector; \$371,591 shall be deemed to
22 come from funds available under the Supplemental
23 Education Grant; \$668,276 shall be deemed to come
24 from funds available under the amended Compact from
25 the health sector; and \$-0- shall be deemed to come
