
I am pleased to transmit the following Congressional Act, which I signed to become Public Law No. 17- 88:

PUBLIC LAW No. 17-88

AN ACT

To further amend sections 1, 3 and 9 of Public Law No. 17-64, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 17-69 and 17-74, in order to appropriate \$3,524,541 in supplemental funding from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013, to make a technical amendment, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 17-64, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 17-69 and 17-74, is hereby further amended to
3 read as follows:

4 "Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to
5 appropriate the sum of \$48,311,395 or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, from the General Fund of the Federated
7 States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
8 September 30, 2013, for the purpose of funding the
9 operations of all branches of the National Government of
10 the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies,
11 various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions,
12 and Capital and Human Resources Development. Of the
13 total amount of funds appropriated herein, \$4,252,868
14 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the
15 amended Compact from the education sector subject to the
16 receipt of Grant Awards under the amended Compact;
17 \$1,168,765 shall be deemed to come from funds available
18 under the Supplemental Education Grant; \$895,705 shall

1 be deemed to come from funds available under the amended
2 Compact from the health sector subject to the receipt of
3 Grant Awards under the amended Compact; \$-0- shall be
4 deemed to come from funds available under the amended
5 Compact from the capacity building sector; \$-0- shall be
6 deemed to come from funds available under the amended
7 Compact from the private sector development sector;
8 \$222,450 shall be deemed to come from funds available
9 under the amended Compact from the enhanced reporting
10 and accountability sector; and \$1,153,025 shall be
11 deemed to come from funds available under the amended
12 Compact from the infrastructure sector."

13 Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 17-64, as amended
14 by Public Laws Nos. 17-69 and 17-74, is hereby further amended
15 to read as follows:

16 "Section 3. Operating Expenses of the Legislative
17 Branch. The sum of \$3,480,228 or so much thereof as
18 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
19 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia
20 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013, for
21 the operations of the Legislative Branch of the
22 National Government during fiscal year 2013. The sum
23 appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as
24 follows:

25 (1) Speaker and Members.

 2 necessary, for the operations of the Office of the
 3 Speaker and Members of the Congress of the Federated

7 Section 3. Section 9 of Public Law No. 17-64, as amended by
8 Public Law No. 17-69 and 17-74, is hereby further amended to read
9 as follows:

10 "Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development.
11 The sum of \$12,834,318, or so much thereof as may be
12 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
13 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
14 year ending September 30, 2013, for the following
15 capital improvements, development programs and projects
16 and human resources development. Of the total amount of
17 funds appropriated herein, \$3,100,000 shall be deemed to
18 come from funds available under the amended Compact from
19 the education sector subject to the receipt of Grant
20 Awards under the amended Compact; \$683,346 shall be
21 deemed to come from funds available under the
22 Supplemental Education Grant; \$390,000 shall be deemed
23 to come from funds available under the amended Compact
24 from the health sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come
25 from funds available under the amended Compact from the

capacity building sector and \$65,000 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the amended Compact from the enhanced reporting and accountability sector. The sum appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as follows:

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
