

Public Law No. 18-87, Congressional Act No. 18-89, "AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 17-68, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAWS NOS. 17-71, 17-81, 17-84, 17-89, 17-90, 18-03, 18-10, 18-13, 18-32, 18-46 AND 18-58, BY AMENDING SECTION 6 THEREIN, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CHANGING THE LAPSE DATE OF CERTAIN FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED TO FUND PUBLIC PROJECTS AND SOCIAL PROGRAMS IN EACH OF THE STATES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

I reviewed the above Acts, designed to alter the funds and change the allottees for various public projects. The numerous amendments, which fail to provide clear direction on the intention of Congress behind altering funds and changing allottees, make it impossible for the Executive branch to implement public projects without involvement from Congress.

The involvement of some members of Congress in the implementation of public projects violates the Constitution, as confirmed by the Udot case. I have previously shared this concern with Congress and once again bring this problem to your attention. Let's resolve this matter amicably and avoid going to court to seek further clarifications.

are used solely for the purpose specified in this
act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the funds
appropriated under section 3 of this act shall be the
Governor of Yap State. The allottee of funds
appropriated under sections 2 and 4 of this act shall
be the President of the Federated States of
Micronesia or his designee, EXCEPT THAT the allottee
of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(a) of
this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation
Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under
subsections 5(1) and 5(3) of this act shall be the
Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The
allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(2)
of section 5 of this act shall be the Mortlock
Islands Development Authority. The allottee of funds
appropriated under subsection 5(4) of section 5 of
this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development
Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under
subsection 5(5) of section 5 of this act shall be the
Faichuk Development Authority. The allottee of funds
appropriated under subsection 5(6) of section 5 of
this act shall be the Northwest Island Development
Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate
funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on
