Presidential Statement on the signing of Congressional Act No. 18-92, entitled: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE \$55,098,704 FROM THE GENERAL FUND OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2015, TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE OPERATIONS OF ALL BRANCHES OF THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA, ITS AGENCIES, VARIOUS PROGRAMS, GRANTS, SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS AND CAPITAL AND HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

I take this opportunity to thank the 18th Congress of the FSM for passing the FY2015 Budget. The domestic revenue projection for the FY2015 Budget is \$66.9 million and of this amount \$52.3 million is appropriated in this Budget Act leaving a remaining balance of \$14.6 million unappropriated.

In reviewing the Act my staff have informed me that there is a discrepancy in the Congressional Act where the total amount for capital and human resource development is listed at \$20,428,549. The correct total for the projects listed in the Act is \$19,878,549. This also means the \$55, 098,704 in Section 1 line 2 of the Act is also in error. This should read \$54,548,704.

I note that the Congress accepted the domestic revenue projection of the Executive Branch as the basis of the budget. This revenue projection was formulated in April this year and therefore has not taken into account the increases in fishing license fees.

The above revenue projection includes \$36 million in fishing license fees compared to an actual collection to date in FY2014 of \$46.9 million. On the basis of this, we would expect license fees to be at least \$47 million in FY2015, or even higher, as the fishing day scheme fees rise from \$6,000 per day to \$8,000 per day on 1 January 2015. Therefore we could anticipate the fiscal surplus in FY2015 to be higher, in the order of \$25 million.

I also thank Congress for appropriating \$10 million into the FSM Trust Fund. While I welcome the \$10 million infusion into the Trust Fund which is in line with the intents and purposes of our Draft 2023 Action Plan, I would ask that Congress urgently consider Congressional Bill 18-206 for the creation of the 2023 Investment Development Fund, a critical key financing component of a package of reforms under the 2023 Action Plan. The Fund and an acceleration of implementation of the infrastructure grant arrears are the stimulus for our economy. I urge Congress to consider the appropriation of the \$15 million for the Fund and to consider the Bill during the session or at the earliest opportunity.

24	(iii) Section 8 (10)(a) through (i) — the
25	allotton of those funds shall be the Speaker of the Congress of

1	the Federated States of Micronesia; and
2	(iv) Section 9(1)(a) through (c) - the
3	allottee of these funds shall be the President of the College of
4	Micronesia-FSM.
5	(v) Section $9(4)(g)$, the allottee of these
6	funds shall be the Governor of Chuuk State.
7	(vi) Section 9(4)(i), the allottee of these
8	funds shall be the Governor of Yap State.
9	(3) Lapse date. The authority of the allottees
10	to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of
11	September 30, 2015; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the funds appropriated
12	under section 9 of this act shall not lapse.
13	Section 14. This act shall become law upon approval by the
14	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
15	becoming law without such approval.
