AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-89, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-102, 18-110, 18-116, 19-02, 19-09, 19-27, and 19-28, by amending sections 1 and 9 thereof, to deapproriate funds previously appropriated therein, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

16	Education Grant funds as is reflected in the budget

6		"Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development.
7		The sum of \$56,260,976 or so much thereof as may be
8		necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General
9		Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the
10		fiscal year ending September 30, 2015, for the
11		following capital improvements, development programs,
12		and projects and human resources development. Of the
13		total amount of funds appropriated herein, \$1,700,000
14		shall be deemed to come from funds available under
15		the Compact Sector Grant for COM-FSM, and \$683,346
16		shall be available from the Supplemental Education
17		Grant, and \$282,339 will be available from amended
18		Compact carry-over funds. The sum appropriated by
19		this section shall be apportioned as follows:
