AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-99, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-106, 18-113, 18-121 and 19-05, by amending sections 2, 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of the States of Yap, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

13	Section 4. Section 6 of Public Law No. 18-99, as amended by
14	Public Laws Nos. 18-113, 18-121 and 19-05, is hereby further amended
15	to read as follows:
16	"Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
17	date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
18	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
19	accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
20	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
21	allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
22	funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
23	solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
24	no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
25	appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated

under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
State or his designee. The allottee of funds
appropriated under section 3 shall be the President or
his designee, EXCEPT THAT the allottee of funds
appropriated under section 3(a), (b), (c), (d), (e),
(f), (g), (h), (i), (j), (k), (l), (m), (n), (o) and (u)
shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government. The
allottee of funds appropriated under section 4 of this
act shall be the President or his designee, EXCEPT that
the allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(1)(a)
shall be the Secretary of the Department of Education;
the allottee of funds appropriated under sections
4(1)(c), 4(1)(e), 4(1)(h) and 4(2) shall be Secretary of
the Department of Transportation, Communications and
Infrastructure; the allottee of funds appropriated under
section 4(1)(d) shall be the Pohnpei Port Authority; the
allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(1)(f)
shall be the Nett District Government; the allottee of
funds appropriated under section 4(1)(g) shall be the
Secretary of the Department of Resources and
Development; the allottee of funds appropriated under
sections 4(3)(b) and 4(4)(a) shall be the Pohnpei
Transportation Authority and the allottee of funds
appropriated under section 4(3)(g) shall be the COM-FSM
Cooperative Extension Service. The allottee of funds

1	appropriated under sections $5(1)$, $5(3)$ and $5(6)$ of this
2	act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his
3	designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
4	subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlock
5	Islands Development Authority. The allottee of funds
6	appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be
7	the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The
8	allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of
9	this act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority.
10	The authority of the allottee to obligate funds
11	appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 30,
12	2016."
13	Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the
14	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
15	becoming law without such approval.
