

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-54, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-62, 19-75 and 19-79, by amending sections 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs in the states of Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

2 Section 3. Section 6 of Public Law No. 19-54, as amended by
3 Public Law No. 19-75, is hereby further amended to read as
4 follows:

5 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and
6 lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall
7 be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for
8 in accordance with applicable laws, including, but
9 not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.
10 The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that
11 these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
12 are used solely for the purpose specified in this
13 act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
14 of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the funds
15 appropriated under section 2 of this act shall be the
16 Governor of Yap State. The allottee of funds
17 appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall
18 be the President of the Federated States of
19 Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the
20 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
21 3(a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g), (h), (i), (j),
22 (k), (l), (m), (n), (o), (p), (q), (r), (s), (t),
23 (u), (v), (ag), (ar) and (as) of this act shall be
24 the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his designee;
25 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections

1 3(w), (x), (y), (z), (aa), (ab), (ac), (ad), (ae),
2 (af), (ah), (ai), (aj), (ak), (al), (am), (an), (ao),
3 (ap) and (aq) of this act shall be the Mayor of
4 Tafunsak Municipal Government or his designee; the
5 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
6 4(1)(a), (b), (c), (e), (f), and 4(2) shall be the
7 Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
8 Communications and Infrastructure or his designee;
9 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
10 4(1)(d), 4(3) (b), 4(3)(d) and 4(3)(l) shall be the
11 Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA). The allottee
12 of funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(w),
13 4(4)(k) and 4(4)(j) shall be Pohnpei PUC. The
14 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
15 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6) of this act shall be the Governor
16 of Chuuk State or his designee. The allottee of
17 funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act
18 shall be the Mortlock Islands Development Authority.
19 The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
20 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas
21 Development Authority. The allottee of funds
22 appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall
23 be the Faichuk Development Authority. The authority
24 of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by
25 this act shall lapse on September 30, 2017."

PUBLIC LAW No. 19-99

1 Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3 becoming law without such approval.
