AN ACT

To simplify the rules and procedures in approving foreign grants by amending section 210 and repealing section 211 of title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), as amended, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Statement of policy. Approving foreign grants
- 2 is presently a role played by Congress. However, delays have
- 3 been experienced in the past with respect to several foreign
- 4 grants because they needed to await for Congress to convene to
- 5 consider their adoption. The intent of this act is to simplify
- 6 the process of approving foreign grants in order to avoid losing
- 7 valuable foreign grants that could be very useful and beneficial
- 8 to FSM citizens.
- 9 Section 2. Section 210 of title 55 of the Code of the
- 10 Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated) as amended, is hereby
- 11 further amended to read as follows:
- 12 "Section 210. Foreign Financial Assistance.
- 13 (1) Definitions.
- 14 (a) "Agreement" shall refer to any agreement,
- understanding, covenant, compact, transacting or other
- agreement, in any form, entered into by and between an
- 17 official of the National Government, or the National
- 18 Government's designee, and a foreign governmental

1	entity, for the receipt or acceptance of financial
2	assistance or aid, on behalf of any National or State
3	governmental entity.
4	(b) "Foreign financial assistance" shall refer
5	to currency, money, accounts or notes receivable
6	offered as aid or assistance to the National
7	Government of the Federated States of Micronesia.,
8	other than foreign aid or assistance received from the
9	United States of America.
10	(c) "Foreign in-kind assistance" shall refer to
11	any and all foreign assistance in the form of goods,
12	services or other modes of assistance not covered
13	under subsection (1)(b) hereof.
14	(2) Approval by Congress. U.S. federally funded
15	program grant awards under \$100,000 do not require
16	approval by Congress by resolution. All other foreign
17	financial assistance in any amount requires approval
18	by Congress by resolution. The President shall submit
19	any agreement for the acceptance or receipt of foreign
20	financial assistance to the Congress no late than the
21	first regular or special session congress convened
22	immediately subsequent to the execution of such
23	agreement, for approval by resolution.
24	(a) No such agreement shall be valid, and no
25	funds may be received pursuant to such agreement,

1	unless and until the requirements of this section have
2	been met. Foreign financial assistance of up to
3	\$10,000 may be disbursed by the President in
4	accordance with the terms and conditions of the
5	assistance.
6	(b) Should the Congress not approve such
7	agreement by resolution before the adjournment of the
8	first regular session following the President's
9	submission of the agreement to Congress, that
10	agreement shall be deemed disapproved.
11	(c) Any first time application for foreign
12	financial assistance shall require the approval by
13	Congress through a resolution.
14	(3) Foreign Assistance Fund. There is hereby
15	established within the National Treasury of the
16	Federated States of Micronesia a Foreign Assistance
17	Fund which shall initially consist of all unobligated
18	balances of foreign assistance funds from the receding
19	fiscal year, and all foreign assistance funds
20	designated for the National government and made
21	available beginning October 1, 1996. Thereafter, the
22	Department of Finance shall receive, maintain a
23	complete record o, and where applicable, deposit all
24	foreign financial assistance as defined in subsection

(1) of this section into the Fund, pursuant to the

1 Financial Management Act of 1979.

- (a) The President or the President's designee shall notify the Congress of the receipt of foreign financial assistance, the amount thereof in U.S. dollars, and, where applicable, the deposit or such assistance into the Fund, no later than the first session of Congress, be it regular or special, convened subsequent to such receipt.
- (b) Where the foreign financial assistance received is denominated in the form of goods or services, the President or the President's designee shall notify the congress of the value thereof in U.S. dollars, and the designation where such goods have been delivered, or location of where such services have been rendered, no later that the first session of the Congress convened subsequent to such receipt.
- (4) Development of Fund Duties of the Department of Finance. The Division of Investment Management of the Department of Finance shall, upon approval of the President and in cooperation with the Department of Foreign Affairs, actively seek foreign assistance funding, foster productive use of foreign assistance, and produce reports on the acquisition, use, expenditure of, and fiscal obligations attendant upon, foreign assistance available to or received by the

2	Micronesia.
3	(5) Reports. No later than April 1 of each year,
4	the President shall submit to the Congress a report on
5	the status of the Foreign Assistance Fund, which
6	report shall include:
7	(a) a complete and accurate accounting of all
8	foreign financial assistance received;
9	(b) a complete and accurate record of the
10	manner in which the foreign financial assistance was
11	distributed as among and between the States and the
12	National Government; and
13	(c) whether such distribution comports with the
14	provisions of article XII, section 1(b) of the
15	Constitution."
16	Section 3. Section 211 of title 55 of the Code of the
17	Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated) as amended, is hereby
18	repealed in its entirety.
