## AN ACT

To amend Section 2 of Public Law No. IC-30 relating to the date and length of regular sessions of the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia for the year 1980 and thereafter, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. IC-30 is hereby amended to read as follows: "Section 2. Congress Sessions in 1980 and thereafter. 3 (1) During the calendar year 1980 and thereafter, the 4 Congress shall meet in two regular sessions commencing on the 5 second Monday in May and the second Monday in October, unless 6 the Presiding Officer shall set a different date or dates. 7 (2) The sessions required by Subsection 1 above shall 8 last for 30 calendar days, unless shortened or extended by a 9 resolution adopted by a majority vote of all members of the 10 11 Congress." Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the 12 President of the Federated States of Micronesia, or upon its becoming 13 law without such approval. 14
