CONGRESSIONAL RESOLUTION NO. 1-12.

A RESOLUTION

Authorizing and directing the Standing Committee on Ways and Means of the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia to essume the duties and responsibilities relating to war claims and other matters formerly assigned to the Joint Committee on Program and Budget Planning, and such other matters related thereto.

- 1 MHEREAS, on November 9, 1978 the Interio Congress of the Federated
- 2 States of Micronesia adopted Senate Joint Resolution No. 2, House Braft
- 3 1, creating a new Joint Committee on Program and Budget Planning composed
- 4 of members of both houses of the Congress representing the Control
- 5 Districts and excluding members from the Marshall Islands and Polau who no
- 6 longer served in the said Congress by virtue of Secretarial Order No. 2027
- 7 which separated their districts fiscally and administratively; and
- 8 THEREAS, the said Joint Committee assumed all the duties and responsi-
- 9 bilities of its producessor Joint Committee in all phases of the formula-
- 10 tion and development of the annual U.S. Grant for the Pederated States of
- 11 Hieronesia: and
- 13 SHERBAS, on Movember 10, 1978 the Interio Congress of the Federated
- 15 States of Micronesia duly adopted House Joint Resolution No. IC-3, Senate
- 14 Braft 1, authorizing the said newly created Joint Committee on Program
- 15 and Budget Planning to also undertake the responsibility ever wer claims
- 16 and other related matters; and
- 17 EMEREAS, with the insuguration of the First Congress of the Pederated
- 18 States of Micronosia, the old bicameral national legislature in the form
- 19 of the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Congress of Microsocia
- 20 and the Interin Congress of the Pederated States of Microsesia went out of
- 21 existence, and at the same time the Joint Committee on Program and Budget
- 22 Planning also became extinct; and

Rule 7 of the Oppicial Rules of Procedure OF THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA. the Committee on Ways and Means as a Standing Committee has within its jurisdiction the broad area of fiscal matters including budgeting, funding arrangements and requirements, government expenditures, appropriation measures, audits and accounting, etc.: and WHEREAS, there is a definite need to inform government agencies within 7 both the Trust Territory Government as well as the United States Congress and the departments and agencies of the United States federal government with which the defunct Joint Committee on Program and Sudget Planning had official contacts or dealings that the Standing Committee on Ways and Moons 11 is estuding the duties formerly assigned to the Joint Committee on Program 12 13 and Budget Planning; now, therefore, BE IT RESCLVED by the First Congress of the Pederated States of 14 16 Micronesia. Pirst Regular Session, 1979, that the Standing Committee on Mayo and Heans of the Congress of the Federated States of Microsesia is 16 17 hereby authorized and directed to assume all the duties and responsibilities formerly assigned to the former Joint Committee on Program and Budget 18 Plenning including war claims and other related matters; and 19 BE IT PURTHER RESOLVED that cortified copies of this Resolution bo 20 transpitted to the following governmental entities and officials advising 21 then of this change of assignment: United States Senators Warron Magnuson, Milton Young, Robort C.
