A RESOLUTION

Relating to the Comprehensive Employment Training Act and Capital Improvement Project.

- WHEREAS, the comprehensive Employment and Training Act of 1973 (CETA) and 1 the CETA Reauthorization Act of 1978 were enacted by the United States Congress to provide job training and employment opportunities for economically disadvantaged, unemployed, or underemployed persons which will result in an increase in their earned income and to assure that training and other services lead to maximum employment opportunities and enhance self-sufficiency; and WHEREAS, CETA, as administered by the Government of the Trust Territory 7 on Saipan, remains separated and distant from the training requirements of the Federated States of Micronesia; and WHEREAS, unemployment and underemployment of persons in the Federated 10 States of Micronesia continue to grow, in particular among the young; and
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- WHEREAS, the common experience in the Federated States of Micronesia 12 is that CETA has not provided job training and employment opportunities to 13
- assure that training and other services lead to maximum employment 14
- opportunities, enhanced self-sufficiency, and increased earned income; and 15
- WHEREAS, CETA has been used to pay persons to perform menial tasks 16
- and to supplement government office personnel without training or hope of 17
- future employment opportunity while expatriates are employed to perform 18
- tasks that Micronesians are not trained to perform; and 19
- WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the administration of United States 20
- federal programs, including CETA, will soon be transferred from the Govern-21
- 22 ment of the Trust Territory to the Federated States of Micronesia pursuant

1 to United States Department of the Interior Order No. 3039; and WHEREAS, hundreds of expatriates are being employed on Capital Improve-2 ment Projects because of a lack of trained Micronesians; and 3 WHEREAS, the utilization of CETA to train Micronesians for employment on Capital Improvement Projects would fulfill the purpose of CETA and provide 5 the Federated States of Micronesia with a necessary and valuable substitute 7 for expatriate labor; now, therefore, BE IT RESOLVED by the First Congress of the Federated States of Micro-8 nesia, Second Regular Session, 1979, that the President of the Federated States of Micronesia is hereby requested to insure that the purpose of CETA is fulfilled upon its transfer to the Federated States of Micronesia and that it be utilized to train Micronesians for employment on Capital Improvement Projects; and 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution be 14 transmitted to the President of the Federated States of Micronesia, and to the Governors and Speakers of State Legislatures of the Federated States of Micronesia. 17 18 Adopted: October 31, 1979 19 20 21 22 23 24 25
