I am pleased to transmit the following Congressional Act, which I have signed to become Public Law No. 21-107:

Congressional Act No. 21-111, entitled: "AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 21-43, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAWS NOS. 21-54, 21-71, 21-82 AND 21-103, BY AMENDING SECTIONS 5 AND 6 THEREOF, TO CHANGE THE USE AND ALLOTTEE OF FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED THEREIN, TO FUND PUBIC PROJECTS AND SOCIAL PROGRAMS FOR THE PEOPLE OF CHUUK STATE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 21-43, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-54, 21-71, 21-82 and 21-103, by amending sections 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Chuuk State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 21-43, as amended by
2	Public Law No. 21-54 and 21-82, is hereby amended to read as

16	Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 21-43, as amended by
17	Public Laws Nos. 21-54 and 21-71, is hereby further amended to
18	read as follows:
19	"Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
20	date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
21	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
22	accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
23	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
24	allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
25	funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used

solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no
obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
State or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of
funds appropriated under subsection 2(f) of this act shall
be the President of the COM-FSM Institute. The allottee
of funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act
shall be the President of the Federated States of
Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of
funds appropriated under subsection 3(1) of this act shall
be the Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; the
allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 3(2) of
this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his
designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
section $4(1)$ and $4(3)(1)$ of this act shall be the Vice
President; The allottee of funds appropriated under
subsection 4(1)(a) and section 4(2) of this act shall be
the Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
Communications and Infrastructure or his designee, except
that the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
4(2)(e), $4(2)(j)$, $4(2)(m)$, $4(4)(j)$, $4(4)(k)$, $4(4)(1)$ and
4(4)(m) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation
Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated under
subsections $4(2)(1)$, $4(3)(d)$ and $4(3)(f)$ of this act shall

be the Secretary of the Department of Education or his
designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
subsection 4(2)(h) of this act shall be the President of
COM-FSM; the allottee of funds appropriated under
subsections 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b), 4(3)(e), 4(3)(h), 4(3)(i)
and 4(3)(k) of this act shall be the Meninkeder of
Madolenihmw; the allottee of funds appropriated under
subsection 4(3)(c) of this act shall be the Chief Justice
of Madolenihmw Municipal Government; the allottee of funds
appropriated under subsection 4(3)(g) of this act shall be
the Luhkenmoanlap of Kitti; the allottee of funds
appropriated under subsection 4(3)(j) of this act shall be
the Speaker of Isokonedi of Kitti; the allottee of funds
appropriated under subsection $4(3)(m)$ of this act shall be
the Director of Pohnpei Public Safety. The allottee of
the funds appropriated under sections 5(1) and 5(6) of
this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his
designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlocks Island
Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of the funds
appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be
the Southern Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee
of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this
act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The
allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(3) of

1	this act shall be the Mayor of Weno Municpal Government of
2	his designee. The authority of the allottee to obligate
3	funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September
4	30, 2022."
5	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
6	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
7	becoming law without such approval.
