

CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 21-212, C.D.1

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-60, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-65, 20-75, 20-85, 20-97, 20-150, 21-69, 21-84 and 21-100, by amending sections 2 and 6 thereof, to change the use, allottee and lapse date of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs in the states of Yap and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 20-60, as amended by
2 Public Law No. 20-65, is hereby further amended to read as
3 follows:

4 "Section 2. Of the \$4,450,000 appropriated under this
5 act, \$850,000 shall be apportioned for public projects
6 and social programs in the state of Yap.

16	Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 20-60, as amended by	
17	Public Laws Nos. 20-65, 20-75 and 20-97, is hereby further amended	
18	to read as follows:	
19	"Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse	
20	date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be	
21	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in	
22	accordance with applicable laws, including, but not	
23	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The	
24	allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these	
25	funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used	

1 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
2 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
3 appropriated. The allottee of funds appropriated under
4 section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State
5 or his designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds
6 appropriated under subsections 2(i), 2(f) and 2(n) of
7 this act shall be the President or his designee. The
8 allottee of the funds appropriated under sections 3 and
9 4 of this act shall be the President of the Federated
10 States of Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT the
11 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 3(a) to
12 3(o) of this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town
13 Government or his designee; the allottee of funds
14 appropriated under subsections 3(p) to 3(ae) of this act
15 shall be the Mayor of Tafunsak Municipal Government or
16 his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
17 subsections 4(2)(e), 4(2)(g) and 4(2)(m) of this act
18 shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA); the
19 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(o)
20 of this act shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation
21 (PUC). The allottee of the funds appropriated under
22 subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of this act shall be the
23 Governor of Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee of
24 the funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act
25 shall be the Mortlocks Island Development Authority

1 (MIDA); the allottee of funds appropriated under
 2 subsection 5(3) of this act shall be the Mayor of Weno
 3 Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of
 4 the funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act
 5 shall be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority;
 6 the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
 7 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk Development
 8 Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate
 9 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September
 10 30, 2022."

11 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
 12 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
 13 becoming law without such approval.
