AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 20-178, by amending sections 3, 4, 5 and 6 therein, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated thereof, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk states, and for other purposes.
