A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend sections 1, 2, and 3 of Public Law No. 6-109, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 7-65, 1-2, 1-50, and 2-4, regarding the Washington Liaison Officer's title, salary, and home leave and changing Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands to Federated States of Micronesia, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: 1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 6-109, as amended by Public Law No. 1-2, is hereby further amended to read as follows: 2 3 "Section 1. There shall be an office to be known as the Micronesian Washington Office' to be located in Washington, District 5 of Columbia, United States of America, which shall be under the direct supervision of a #141464 Afficet Special Representative of the President of the Tederated States of Micronesia in accordance with the provisions of this act. The Liaifor Officet Special Representative of the President of the Federated States of Micro-10 nesia shall be appointed by the President of the Federated States 11 of Micronesia, with the advice and consent of the Congress of the 12 Federated States of Micronesia. The Liaison Officet Special 13 Representative of the President of the Federated States of Micro-14 nesia serves at the pleasure of the President." 15 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 6-109, as amended by Public Laws 16 Nos. 1-2, 1-50, and 2-4, is hereby further amended to read as follows: "Section 2. The #14146# Offffet Special Representative of the 17 President of the Federated States of Micronesia shall maintain the .48 office headquarters in Washington, D.C., and shall have the power 19 to employ such secretarial, clerical, technical, and professional 20 assistants as he may deem necessary to the fulfilling of his duties 21 and responsibilities, subject to appropriations for his office. He 22 23 shall represent the people of the Federated States of Micronesia on a full-time basis before the Congress of the United States and before 24

the various departments and agencies of the Federal Government and

	Secti	ion 3. Section 3 of Public Law No. 6-109, as amended by Public Laws
Nos.	7-65	and 1-2, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
		"Section 3. The Ligison of the Special Representative of the
		President of the Federated States of Micronesia shall be paid an
		annual salary of \$ 14100 $21,000$, which salary shall not be diminished
		during his tenure of office. In addition thereto, he shall receive

1	an allowance each fiscal year for secretarial, clerical, technical,
2	and professional assistance, and for all office expenses, in-
3	cluding office rental and equipment, and such other and further
4	expenses as may be allowed by the Congress of the Federated
5	States of Micronesia by appropriation. The Lidison Officet
6	Special Representative of the President of the Federated States
7	of Micronesia and his family shall be permitted one paid round
