#### AN ACT

2	responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
3	necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this act,
4	and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated.
5	The authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this
6	act shall lapse as of September 30, 1982.
7	Section 11. Effective date. This act shall become law upon
8	approval by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or
9	upon its becoming law without such approval.
