A RESOLUTION

Respectfully requesting the United States Department of the Interior and the United States Congress to continue funding capital improvement projects in the Federated States of Micronesia beyond fiscal year 1984.

- 1 WHEREAS, the Federated States of Micronesia needs an infrastructure
- 2 of physical facilities for meaningful economic development; and
- 3 WHEREAS, development of such infrastructure has continually been
- 4 funded under the capital improvement projects but is still inadequate;
- 5 and
- 6 WHEREAS, under a 5-year plan, funding for capital improvement
- 7 projects may be discontinued in fiscal year 1984; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the United States Department of the Interior is taking the
- 9 position that its obligation to fund capital improvement projects will
- 10 cease with the funding of such projects in fiscal year 1984; and
- 11 WHEREAS, it is the sense of the Third Congress of the Federated
- 12 States of Micronesia that for meaningful economic development the United
- 13 States has a continuing obligation to fund capital improvement projects and
- 14 has not fully discharged its obligation to provide for an adequate
- 15 infrastructure in the Federated States of Micronesia; now, therefore,
- 16 BE IT RESOLVED by the Third Congress of the Federated States of
- 17 Micronesia, First Special Session, 1983, that the Congress respectfully
- 18 requests the Department of the Interior and the United States Congress to
- 19 continue funding capital improvement projects in the Federated States of
- 20 Micronesia beyond fiscal year 1984; and
- 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution
- 22 be transmitted to High Commissioner of the Trust Territory of the
- 23 Pacific Islands Janet J. McCoy, Secretary of the United States
- 24 Department of the Interior James Watt, Chairman James A. McClure of the
- 25 Senate Committee on Natural Resources of the United States Congress,
