- WHEREAS, the Job Corps Center has prepared said youths to effectively
- 16 meet the challenges encountered in the pursuit of their careers and

- 18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Third Congress of the Federated States of
- 19 Micronesia, Fourth Regular Session, 1984, that the Job Corps Center in
- 20 Honolulu be, and the same hereby is, commended for the outstanding role it
- 21 plays in the development of the youths of this Nation; and
- 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this resolution be
- 23 transmitted to the director of the Job Corps Center in Honolulu, Hawaii.
