A RESOLUTION

Respectfully requesting the President of the Federated States of Micronesia to join with the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia in establishing a joint task force to study the issue of compensation and benefits for National Government employees.

- WHEREAS, a lack of consistency exists among National Government
- 2 exempt employees as to what compensation and benefits they should
- 3 equitably receive; and
- 4 WHEREAS, an anomalous situation is now in the making whereby
- 5 certain regular employees of the Public Service System are eligible for
- 6 more compensation then exempt employees who are supervising them; and
- 7 WHEREAS, several measures have been introduced into the Congress
- 8 of the Federated States of Micronesia which seek to remedy these
- 9 personnel problems, but a lack of consensus has prevented a comprehensive
- 10 scheme from emerging which will alleviate these problems; and
- 11 WHEREAS, it is the belief of the Congress that the best way to
- 12 develop a comprehensive approach to compensation and benefits problems
- 13 is to establish a joint task force in this regard; and
- 14 WHEREAS, it is the belief of the Congress that it is now timely
- 15 and appropriate to establish within the next 30 days a joint task force
- 16 which will have the mandate of analyzing these compensation and benefits
- 17 problems and making specific recommendations to alleviate these problems;
- 18 now, therefore,
- 19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Third Congress of the Federated States of
- 20 Micronesia, Fourth Regular Session, 1984, that the President of the
- 21 Federated States of Micronesia is respectfully requested to join the
- 22 Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia in establishing a joint
- 23 task force which will have the mandate of analyzing compensation and
- 24 benefits problems of the National Government and making recommendations
- 25 to alleviate these problems; and
