A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend section 1 of Public Law No. 3-57, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 3-62, and 3-85, for the purpose of reapportioning funds appropriated for public projects in the State of Pohnpei, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 3-57, as amended by Public

2 Laws Nos. 3-62, and 3-85, is hereby further amended to read as follows:


