A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend title 32 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia by adding a new chapter 5 concerning peddlers; to further amend title 50 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Law No. 4-25, by amending section 103 by adding a new subsection (3) to provide for peddler's permits; by renumbering subsections (3) through (9) of section 103; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
Section 1. Title 32 of the Code of the Federated States of
Micronesia is hereby amended by adding a new section 501 of chapter
5 to read as follows:
"Section 501. Definitions. As used in this chapter,
unless common sense or the context otherwise requires:
(1) 'Noncitizen peddler' means a person who is
a peddler pursuant to the definition in subsection (2)
of this section and is neither a citizen nor a national
of the Federated States of Micronesia.
(2) 'Peddler' means a person who travels from house
to house, village to village, or island to island, for
the purpose of selling or taking orders for the purchase
of goods or services, who is without local place of
habitation or local place of business. The term 'peddler'
includes peddlers, hawkers, solicitors, itinerant vendors,
transient vendors, itinerant traders, transient traders,
itinerant merchants, transient merchants, traveling
merchants, drummers, traveling salespersons, and the like,
whether engaged in wholesale or retail sales. The term
'peddler' shall only apply to citizen peddlers if they are
engaged in interstate commerce. The term 'peddler' does not
apply to persons who make only a single or occasional sale."
Section 2. Title 32 of the Code of the Federated States of

24 Micronesia is hereby amended by adding a new section 502 of chapter

25 5 to read as follows:

1	"Section 502. Immigration requirements. All noncitizen
2	peddlers entering the Federated States of Micronesia for the
3	purpose of doing business must obtain a peddler's permit as
4	described in subsection (3) of section 103 of title 50 of
5	the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia."
6	Section 3. Title 32 of the Code of the Federated States of
7	Micronesia is hereby amended by adding a new section 503 of chapter
8	5 to read as follows:
9	"Section 503. Taxation. Peddlers shall be subject to all
10	applicable national taxes, including, but not limited to,
11	the gross revenue and import taxes established pursuant to
12	title 54 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia."
13	Section 4. Title 32 of the Code of the Federated States of
14	Micronesia is hereby amended by adding a new section 504 of chapter
15	5 to read as follows:
16	"Section 504. Foreign investment permits. Noncitizen
17	peddlers must comply with the foreign investment permit
18	requirements of chapter 2 of this title."
19	Section 5. Title 32 of the Code of the Federated States of
20	Micronesia is hereby amended by adding a new section 505 of chapter
21	5 to read as follows:
22	"Section 505. Other National and State laws. Nothing in
23	this chapter shall be construed as exempting peddlers from
24	other National and State laws, including laws concerning
25	requirements for business licenses."

1	Section 6. Title 32 of the Code of the Federated States of
2	Micronesia is hereby amended by adding a new section 506 of chapter
3	5 to read as follows:
4	"Section 506. Compliance. If a peddler does not make a
5	good faith effort to substantially comply with this chapter,
6	any sales made or contracts entered into while he is in
7	violation of this chapter shall be considered void, and the
8	peddler shall not be entitled to relief in the Supreme Court
9	of the Federated States of Micronesia in any action he
10	brings for accounts due on such sales or contracts. This
11	legal disability shall be in addition to, and not a
12	substitute for, any other legal consequences of
13	noncompliance."
14	Section 7. Title 32 of the Code of the Federated States of
15	Micronesia is hereby amended by adding a new section 507 of chapter
16	5 to read as follows:
17	"Section 507. Separability. If any part of this chapter
18	is declared unconstitutional by a court of competent
19	jurisdiction, that decision shall not affect any portion
20	of the chapter which remains, and the remainder shall be
21	in full force and effect as if the portion declared
22	unconstitutional had never been a part of the act. If
23	the application of this chapter to a particular type or
24	class of peddler is declared unconstitutional by a court
25	of competent jurisdiction, this chapter shall remain in

1	force as it applies to peddlers not of that type or within
2	that class."
3	Section 8. Section 103 of title 50 of the Code of the Federated
4	States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows:
5	"Section 103. Entry permits - Types.
6	(1) A permit is not required for a person visiting for
7	thirty days or less. For a visit in excess of thirty days
8	a permit may be issued for an additional period not to
9	exceed sixty days.
10	(2) A visitor's permit for any lawful purpose,
11	including performance of necessary services on a short-
12	term contractual basis, may be issued for a period of
13	specified duration reflecting the time necessary to
14	accomplish the purpose.
15	(3) Notwithstanding any provision of subsections
16	(1) and (2) of this section, a person entering the
17	Federated States of Micronesia for the purpose of
18	engaging in business as a noncitizen peddler, as defined in
19	section 501 of title 32 of the Code of the Federated
20	States of Micronesia, shall be issued a peddler's
21	permit.
22	(34) An alien worker's permit shall be issued to a
23	noncitizen entering the Federated States of Micronesia upon
24	compliance with all National laws relating to private or
25	governmental employment for the period in which the employ-

ment of the alien worker is authorized by contract. The permit shall be renewed upon extension or renewal of the alien's lawful employment status.

- (45) A foreign investor's entry permit shall be issued for a specified duration and may be renewed upon renewal or extension of such foreign investor's business permit.
- (36) A researcher's entry permit shall be issued for research in the fields of endeavor that the President deems in the best interest of and for the well-being of the citizens of the Federated States of Micronesia; provided that the President receives from the researcher's intended place of stay prior permission for his entry. The President may attach thereto such conditions or restrictions as he deems necessary.
- (67) A missionary's permit shall be issued to a duly ordained, licensed, and certified minister or clergyman. A missionary's permit may also be issued to persons whose activities are substantially connected with religious or missionary work as determined by the President.
- (78) An entry permit shall be issued to a lawful spouse of a citizen. The permit shall be revoked or shall be denied upon a finding that the parties are divorced or irreconcilably separated, or that the citizen-spouse is deceased. The President or his designee has the authority to grant or reissue the permit for indefinite duration upon a

1	finding of hardship.
2	(89) A dependent's entry permit may be issued to an
3	unmarried child, under the age of eighteen, or a
4	noncitizen spouse subject to the conditions in subsection
5	(78) of this section.
6	$(9\underline{10})$ A spouse or unmarried child under the age of
7	eighteen of any noncitizen principal listed in this section
8	except subsection ($\$9$) may be issued an entry permit for
9	the duration of the principal's entry permit and may be
10	renewed upon renewal of the principal's entry permit."
11	Section 9. This act shall take effect 90 days after approval
12	by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia, or 90 days
13	after its becoming law without such approval.
