A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend section 2 of Public Law No. 4-28, Truk State public projects, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 4-43, 4-64, 4-67, and 4-97, by amending subsection (3)(b)(i) to change the purpose of the appropriation for Nechap, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 4-28, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 4-43, 4-64, 4-67, and 4-97, is hereby further
3 amended to read as follows:
