

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 4-51 by amending sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10, for the purpose of appropriating the sum of \$2,010,474 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1987, as supplemental funding for the operations of the executive branch, Congress, Public Auditor, FSM Telecommunications Corporation, National Fisheries Corporation, Commission on Future Political Status and Transition, Micronesian Maritime Authority, Postal Services, and for certain other programs and contributions of the National Government; adjusting employment ceilings; exempting certain appropriations from lapse date restrictions; eliminating references to the U.S. Grant Special Fund to reflect its abolishment under Public Law No. 4-77; by adding new sections 6, 8, and 9 to establish a development budget and to appropriate special funds available under the Compact of Free Association; by repealing section 9 in its entirety; to renumber section 8 and amend the provisions regarding reprogramming; to renumber sections 6, 7, 10 and 11; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 4-51 is hereby amended
2 to read as follows:

3 "Section 1. Operating expenses of the executive branch. The
4 sum of \$7,247,468, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
5 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
6 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
7 September 30, 1987, for the operations of the executive
8 branch of the National Government of the Federated States of
9 Micronesia during fiscal year 1987. The sum appropriated
10 by this section shall be apportioned as follows:

23 ending September 30, 1987, for the operations of the
24 legislative branch of the National Government of the
25 Federated States of Micronesia during fiscal year 1987.

8 "Section 3. Operating expenses of the National judiciary.

9 The sum of \$617,772, or so much thereof as may be
10 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
11 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year
12 ending September 30, 1987, for the operations of the
13 National judiciary of the Federated States of Micronesia
14 during fiscal year 1987. The sum appropriated by this
15 section shall be apportioned as follows:

1 States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30,
2 1987, for the operations of the Public Auditor's Office
3 during fiscal year 1987. The sum appropriated by this
4 section shall be apportioned as follows:

15 Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
16 year ending September 30, 1987, for the operations of
17 independent agencies, commissions, authorities, boards,
18 bureaus, and other organizations of the National Government
19 of the Federated States of Micronesia during fiscal year
20 1987. The sum appropriated by this section shall be
21 apportioned as follows:

14 Section 6. Public Law No. 4-51 is hereby amended by adding a
15 new section 6 to read as follows:

16 "Section 6. Development budget. The sum of \$741,000, or
17 so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated
18 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia
19 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1987, for capital
20 improvement/development programs and projects of the
21 National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia
22 during fiscal year 1987. The money appropriated under this
23 section shall be deemed to have come from the capital account
24 of the Compact of Free Association. The sum appropriated by
25 this section shall be apportioned as follows:

1 hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated
2 States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30,
3 1987, for special programs, grants, subsidies, contributions,
4 and refunds of the National Government of the Federated
5 States of Micronesia during fiscal year 1987. The sum
6 appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as follows:

10 Section 8. Public Law No. 4-51 is hereby amended by adding a new
11 section 8 to read as follows:

12 "Section 8. Marine surveillance. The sum of \$125,000, or so
13 much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from
14 the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
15 the fiscal year ending September 30, 1987, for the purpose of
16 funding a program of marine surveillance during fiscal year
17 1987. The funds appropriated under this section shall be
18 deemed to come from the funds available under section 216(a)
19 (1) of the Compact of Free Association."

20 Section 9. Public Law No. 4-51 is hereby amended by adding a new
21 section 9 to read as follows:

22 "Section 9. Telecommunications operations. The sum of
23 \$724,200, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby
24 appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of
25 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1987, for

1 the purpose of partially funding the operations of the
2 Telecommunications Corporation during fiscal year 1987.
3 The funds appropriated under this section shall be deemed to
4 come from the funds available under section 215(a)(2) of the
5 Compact of Free Association."

6 Section 10. Section 7 of Public Law No. 4-51 is hereby amended to
7 read as follows:

8 "Section 10. Employment ceilings. Subsection (1) sets forth
9 the maximum number of positions that may be hired by branches
10 and agencies of the National Government.

8 Section 11. Section 9 of Public Law No. 4-51 is hereby repealed
9 in its entirety.

10 Section 12. Section 8 of Public Law No. 4-51 is hereby amended to
11 read as follows:

12 "Section 11. Reprogramming.

13 (1) The President or his designee may reprogram up to
14 10 percent to and from the funds appropriated to each of the
15 subsections in section 1, and may reprogram up to 15 percent
16 to and from the funds appropriated in each of the paragraphs
17 within the subsections of section 1.

18 (2) The Speaker or his designee may reprogram up to 10
19 percent to and from the funds appropriated to each of the
20 subsections in section 2, and may reprogram up to 15 percent
21 to and from the funds appropriated in each of the paragraphs
22 within the subsections of section 2.

23 (3) The Chief Justice or his designee may reprogram up
24 to 15 percent to and from the funds appropriated in each of
25 the subsections in section 3.

1 (4) The Public Auditor may reprogram up to 15 percent
2 to and from the funds appropriated in each of the subsections
3 in section 4.

4 (5) Allottees of funds may reprogram up to 15 percent
5 to and from the funds appropriated in each of the paragraphs
6 within the subsections of section 5.

7 (6) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsections (1)
8 through (5) of this section, no funds may be reprogrammed
9 from any personnel account."

10 Section 13. Section 10 of Public Law No. 4-51 is hereby amended
11 to read as follows:

12 "Section 12. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
13 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
14 managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with
15 applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial
16 Management Act of 1979, as amended. Each allottee shall be
17 responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof
18 as may be necessary, are used solely for the purposes speci-
19 fied in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in
20 excess of the sum appropriated. No funds provided by sub-
21 sections (3)(a) and (3)(b) of section 6 of this act may be
22 obligated until the National Government obtains either title
23 to the land on which the buildings are to be constructed or a
24 leasehold interest to the land on which the buildings are to
25 be constructed of a duration equal to the useful life of the

1 buildings. The authority of the allottees to obligate funds
2 appropriated by this act, except those appropriated by
3 sections 6, 7(7) and 9, shall lapse as of September 30, 1987."

4 Section 14. Section 11 of Public Law No. 4-51 is hereby
5 renumbered as section 13.

6 Section 15. This act shall become law upon approval by the
7 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
8 law without such approval.
