A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend section 2 of Public Law No. 4-93, Pohnpei State public projects, as amended by Public Law No. 4-107, for the purpose of reapportioning certain funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1       Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 4-93, as amended by  
2   Public Law No. 4-107, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
