A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend sections 2 and 3 of Public Law No. 4-93, Pohnpei State public projects, as amended by Public Law No. 4-107, for the purpose of clarifying the purpose for which funds are appropriated; extending the lapse date for all funds appropriated, except those appropriated under subsection 4(1) of section 2; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 4-93, as amended by
2 Public Law No. 4-107, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
3 "Section 2. The sum appropriated under section 1 of this

12. Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 4-93, as amended by Public
13. Law No. 4-107, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

14. "Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
15. allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in
16. accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited
17. to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall
18. be the Governor of Pohnpei State for all the appropriations
19. herein, except that the Pohnpei Community Action Agency shall
20. be the allottee for appropriations under subsection (2) of
21. section 2, the Menin Keder Lapalap of the Madolenihmw
22. Municipal Government shall be the allottee for appropriations
23. under subsection (1)(a) of section 2, the Luhken Menlap of the
24. Kitti Municipal Government shall be the allottee for appro-
25. priations under subsection (1)(b) of section 2, the Chief

1 Magistrate of Sokehs shall be the allottee for appropriations
2 under subsection (3)(a) of section 2, the Kolonia Town Mayor
3 shall be the allottee for appropriations under subsection
4 (3)(b) of section 2, the Luhkenkolwof of Sapwuahfik shall be
5 the allottee for all appropriations under subsection (3)(c)
6 of section 2, and the Pohnpei Farmers Home Administration
7 Office shall be the allottee for appropriations under
8 subsections (1)(a)(xxix), (1)(b)(xxviii), and (4)(f) of
9 section 2. The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring
10 that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are
11 used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and that
12 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated.
13 The authority of the allottees to obligate all funds appro-
14 priated by this act, except those appropriated under sub-
15 section (4)(1) of section 2, shall lapse as of September 30,
16 19871988. The funds appropriated under subsection (4)(1) of
17 section 2 shall not lapse."

18 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
19 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
20 law without such approval.
