A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 4 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 3-3 and 3-40, by adding a new chapter 3 concerning admission to practice before the Supreme Court of the Federated States of Micronesia, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- Section 1. Title 4 of the Code of the Federated States of Micro-2 nesia is hereby further amended by the addition of a new section 301
- 3 of chapter 3 to read as follows:
- "Section 301. Rules for admission to practice. 4 5 Court of the Federated States of Micronesia may adopt rules governing admission to practice before the Supreme Court of 6 the Federated States of Micronesia; PROVIDED, however, that 7 such rules must be consistent with this chapter. Any such rules which took effect prior to this chapter becoming law 9 shall, to the extent they are not in conflict with this 10 11 chapter, remain in full force and effect unless and until amended or repealed by court order or law." 12
- Section 2. Title 4 of the Code of the Federated States of Micro-14 nesia is hereby further amended by the addition of a new section 302 15 of chapter 3 to read as follows:
- "Section 302. Law school graduation requirement.
- (1) Unless one of the exceptions contained in sub-17 18 sections (2) and (3) of this section are applicable, no person may be admitted to practice before the Supreme Court 19 of the Federated States of Micronesia unless he has 20 graduated from a law school whose graduates are entitled, 21 upon fulfillment of requirements generally applicable in 22 that jurisdiction for graduates of accredited law schools, 23 24 to admission as attorneys to practice in the jurisdiction where the law school is located. 25

1	(2) Subsection (1) of this section shall not apply to
2	persons seeking to appear only in a particular case.
3	(3) Subsection (1) of this section shall not apply
4	to any person admitted to practice before the Supreme Court
5	prior to the effective date of this act so long as such
6	person continously maintains his eligibility to practice
7	before the Supreme Court."
8	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
9	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
10	law without such approval.
