A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 52 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Law No. 5-21, by amending sections 161 through 165, 203, 206, 209 and 210, to establish a single base salary system, by repealing sections 207 and 208, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: Section 1. Section 161 of title 52 of the Code of the Federated 1 States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows: "Section 161. Salary schedule. 3 (1) Salary schedule. There shall be a single salary 4 schedule for all employees and positions in the National public service system. The Pérsønnel Øfficer Director of Administrative Services shall assign each class of 7 positions to an appropriate salary level of such schedule. 8 (2) Statutory enactment. No salary schedule or 9 change in any salary schedule for employees of the National 10 Public Service System, except those excluded by the 11 provisions of this chapter, shall be effective unless it 12 shall have been enacted into law by the Congress of the 1.3 Federated States of Micronesia." 14 Section 2. Section 162 of title 52 of the Code of the Federated 15 States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows: "Section 162. Periodic review of plan. The Personnel 17 Øffiter Director of Administrative Services shall 18 periodically conduct necessary and appropriate studies of 19 rates of compensation and pay-related practices in all 20 geographic areas from which employees for the public 21 service are normally recruited and shall adopt such 22 amendments to the existing compensation plan as he deems 23 appropriate; provided that when the amendment includes 24

changes in the salary schedule, the rates or nature of

1	differentials or allowances, or other subjects covered in
2	this subthapter title or in other laws, the Personnel
3	Øfficer Director of Administrative Services shall submit
4	the recommendations to the President for review, approval,
5	and further transmittal to the Congress for its
6	consideration, and that such amendment shall become
7	effective only after it has been enacted into law. In
8	developing amendments, the Personnel Officer Director of
9	Administrative Services shall give consideration to:
10	(1) the minimum standard of living which is
11	compatible with decency and health;
12	(2) the general economic conditions of the Federated
13	States of Micronesia;
14	(3) compensation practices and conditions of
15	appropriate labor markets;
16	(4) conditions of employment in the National Public
17	Service System;
18	(5) the financial resources estimated to be available
19	to the ¢¢ntral Government of the Federated States of
20	Micronesia;
21	(6) such other matters as the Personnel Officer
22	Director of Administrative Services may deem appropriate."
23	Section 3. Section 163 of title 52 of the Code of the Federated
24	States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows:
25	"Section 163. Přemínnsk To řekognite kiřkunstankes of

18	Micronesia may be paid a premium based on Yabor market
19	conditions in the place of assignment and on the level of
20	the base salary shall receive a premium differential only
21	where a cost of living condition is higher than the current
22	standard in the Federated States of Micronesia."
23	Section 4. Section 164 of title 52 of the Code of the Federated
24	States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows:
25	"Section 164. <u>Differentials</u> . To compensate for unusual

circumstances of employment which create hardships for public service employees, the following differentials are provided for them; provided that in no case may an employee receive differentials under both subsections (1) and (2) of this section: (1) Night work differential. An employee whose tour of duty includes regularly scheduled hours falling between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. shall be paid a differential of fifteen percent of the adjusted base salary for all hours falling within that period. (2) Hazardous work differential. An employee whose position entails unusual and extreme hazards to his health or safety shall be paid a differential of twenty-five percent of the adjusted base salary for all hours in which hazardous work is performed. (3) Overtime differential. An employee shall be paid overtime compensation at the rate of time and one-half of his adjusted base salary for all time when he is directed

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- overtime compensation at the rate of time and one-half of his adjusted base salary for all time when he is directed to work and does work in excess of eight hours in one day; or when he is directed to work and does work on the sixth or seventh day of the work week; provided that he has first worked forty hours at straight time in the same work week; and provided further, that overtime work performed on a holiday shall be subject to subsection (4) of this section.
 - (4) Holiday differential. An employee who is

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1	required to work on a legal holiday shall be compensated at
2	double his adjusted base salary for all such hours worked.
3	(5) Typhoon <u>Declared</u> emergency differential.
4	Employees who are required to work in a location and a
5	period in which a typhoon of other natural catastrophe
6	temporary emergency has been declared by tompetent
7	authority the President or his designee, and in which other
8	Government employees are released from work because of such
9	conditions, shall be compensated for the hours worked while
10	such emergency remains in force at the rate of two and
11	one-half times the adjusted base salary. The differential
12	provided in this subsection shall not limit the employee's
13	right to any other differential or allowance to which he
14	may otherwise be entitled by law or regulations."
15	Section 5. Section 165 of title 52 of the Code of the Federated
16	States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows:
17	"Section 165. Transfer allowance. To compensate employees
18	for unusual expenses resulting from changes of work
19	location, the following allowance is provided to public
20	service employees:
21	(1) When an employee is recruited or transferred
22	beyond normal commuting distance from his parter place of
23	permanent resident for work elsewhere, he shall be entitled
24	to all justifiable expenses connected with travel of
25	himself and his immediate family to the new work location

1	and transportation of a reasonable quantity of household
2	effects.
3	(2) He shall be entitled to an allowance equal to per
4 .	diem at the established rate for the new duty station for a
5	period not exceeding fifteen calendar days from the date of
6	entry into the new position."
7	Section 6. Section 203 of title 52 of the Code of the Federated
8	States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows:
9	"Section 203. <u>Definitions</u> . Except as otherwise provided
10	in this section, or unless the context clearly requires
11	otherwise, terms used in this chapter shall have the
12	meaning ascribed in section 112 of this title.
13	(1) 'Foreign-service premium' means a premium to be
14	paid in addition to base salary to employees who are
15	dititens of the Trust Territory assigned to permanent duty
16	stations outside the Trust Territory Federated States of
17	Micronesia.
18	(1) Inatketthiate ptenium/ neams a ptenium based on

25	Section 7. Section 206 of title 52 of the Code of the Federated

1	States	of	Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows:
2			"Section 206. Compensation of employees who att tititens of
3			the Itust Tettitoty.
4		÷	(1) Except as otherwise hereinafter provided, employees
5.			Who are citizens of the Trust Territory Federated States of
6			Micronesia National Government shall receive as compensation a
7			base salary as provided in section 205 of this chapter.
8			(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1)
9			of this section, any employee covered under the provisions
10			thereof who has achieved advanced professional status
11			through obtaining an earned professional degree or
12			certificate in law, an eathed doctotate in any other field,
13			ot an eathed degree in professional engineering awarded on

11	Section 8. Sections 207 and 208 of title 52 of the Code of the
12	Federated States of Micronesia are hereby repealed in their entirety.
13	Section 9. Section 209 of title 52 of the Code of the Federated
14	States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows:
15	"Section 109 207. Entrance salary rate of employees.
16	(1) The initial base salary rate of a new employee
17	shall be at step 1 of the pay level for the class of his/her
18	position unless the Pérsonnél Offlicer Director of
19	Administrative Services determines that a higher rate is
20	needed for recruitment and that such higher rate is
21	appropriate to the qualifications of the applicant;
22	provided that in no case shall such rate be higher than
23	step 4 of the pay level for the class of the position.
24	(2) Any employee who receives a promotion within the
25	National Public Service System shall have his base salary

_	increased to that step in the pay level for the new
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2	position which is next higher than but not exceeding step 4
3	of the step pay level at which his current salary is fixed,
4.	unless his current salary is higher than step 7 of the pay
5	level, in which case his salary shall remain whichanged may
6	not exceed step 7 of the new level.
7	(3) An employee who receives a transfer within the
8	National Public Service System shall continue to be paid at
9	the same pay level and step as before the transfer, and his
10	time in grade shall continue to be counted as if the
11	transfer had not taken place.
12	14) An employee who tecelyes a promotion of transfet
13	from the Trust Territory public service to the Mational
14	Public Setylce System shall be entitled to a salatyl within
15	the pay level for the new positions which the Petsonnel
16	officet finds to be appropriate in view of the employeels
17	qualifications and his salaty in the Trust Tettitoty
18	administration. In no case shall the new salary be higher
19	than step 7 of the pay level for the tlass of the position!"
20	Section 10. Section 210 of title 52 of the Code of the
21	Federated States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows:
22	"Section 210208. Existing employment contracts. The
23	provisions of this chapter shall not impair, change,
24	increase, or decrease the obligations of any existing
25	employment contract to which the central Government of the

1	Federated States of Micronesia is or becomes party. Every
2	position to be filled after the effective date of this
3	chapter by initial contractual appointment or renewal of
4	existing contract shall provide for compensation as
5	specified in the provisions of this chapter.
6	Section 11. This act shall become law upon approval by the
7	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
8	law without such approval.
