FIFTH CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA

FOURTH SPECIAL SESSION, 1989 CONGRESSIONAL BILL No. 5-435, C.D.1, C.D.2, C.D.3, C.D.4, C.D.5, C.D.6, C.D.7, C.D.8

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 5-52, as amended, by further amending sections 1, 4, 5, 7, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-55, 5-73, 5-83, 5-90, 5-101, 5-106 and 5-110, for the purpose of appropriating the sum of \$1,655,067 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1989, as supplemental funding for the executive branch, Public Auditor, agencies of the National Government, Compact section 221(b) programs, National Government programs, grants, subsidies, contributions, and refunds, development budget; reallocating funds for marine surveillance program; adjusting employment ceilings; limiting reprogramming authority; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: Section 1. 10	Section 9. Section 15 of Public Law No. 5-52, as amended by Public
11	Law No. 5-55, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
12	"Section 15. Reprogramming.
13	(1) The President or his designee may reprogram up to
14	10 percent to and from the funds appropriated to each of the
15	subsections in section 1, and may reprogram up to 15 percent
16	to and from the funds appropriated in each of the paragraphs
17	within the subsections of section 1.
18	(2) The Speaker or his designee may reprogram up to 10
19	percent to and from the funds appropriated to each of the
20	subsections in section 2, and may reprogram up to 15 percent
21	to and from the funds appropriated in each of the paragraphs
22	within the subsections of section 2.
23	(3) The Chief Justice or his designee may reprogram
24	up to 15 percent to and from the funds appropriated in each
25	of the subsections in section 3.

1	(4) The Public Auditor may reprogram up to 15 percent
2	to and from the funds appropriated in each of the sub-

4	(5) Allottees of funds may reprogram up to 15 percent
5	to and from the funds appropriated in each of the paragraphs
6	within the subsections of section 5.
7	(6) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsections (1)
8	through (5) of this section, no funds may be reprogrammed
9	from any personnel account or from the amounts appropriated
10	under subsection (3)(e) of section 1."
11	Section 10. This act shall become law upon approval by the President
12	of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without
13	such approval.
