AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 4-95, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 4-113, 5-14, 5-29, 5-30 and 5-44, by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 4-113, 5-14, 5-30 and 5-44, for the purpose of changing the use of funds for certain public projects, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1       Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 4-95, as amended by  
2    Public Laws Nos. 4-113, 5-14, 5-30 and 5-44, is hereby further amended  
3    to read as follows:

9 law without such approval.


