

To further amend Public Law No. 6-10, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 6-43 and 6-46, by further amending sections 1, 4, 5, 7 and 12, as amended by Public Law No. 6-43, for the purpose of appropriating the sum of \$929,369 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1990, as supplemental funding for the executive branch, the Public Auditor, agencies of the National Government, the Marine Surveillance Program, and other National Government programs, grants, subsidies, contributions, and refunds; by amending section 14 for the purpose of modifying employment ceilings; by amending section 15 for the purpose of modifying the authority to reprogram funds; by amending section 16 for the purpose of modifying lapse dates; and for other purposes.

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 6-10, as amended by
2 Public Law No. 6-43, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
3 "Section 1. Operating expenses of the executive branch.
4 The sum of ~~\$\$871,655~~ 9,431,524, or so much thereof as may
5 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
6 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year
7 ending September 30, 1990, for the operations of the
8 executive branch of the National Government of the
9 Federated States of Micronesia during fiscal year 1990. As
10 required by Public Law No. 5-119, the Congress of the
11 Federated States of Micronesia hereby declares that the
12 funding appropriated by this section is deemed to be
13 essential. The sum appropriated by this section shall be
14 apportioned as follows:

(2) The number of positions authorized applies individually to each of the departments and offices of the executive and legislative branches, the National judiciary, the Public Auditor, and to the agencies as provided in subsection (1) of this section, except that the President may transfer up to 12 positions between the departments and offices of the executive branch. This authorization of positions covers all permanent employees and all contract personnel whose employment extends for 1 year or more except employees providing janitorial services. No funds may be expended for unbudgeted positions."

1 Section 7. Section 15 of Public Law No. 6-10 is hereby amended
2 to read as follows:

3 "Section 15. Reprogramming.

4 (1) The President or his designee may reprogram up to
5 10 percent to and from the funds appropriated to each of
6 the subsections and paragraphs in section 1. The President
7 or his designee may reprogram up to 15 percent to and from
8 the funds appropriated in any of the subparagraphs within
9 the same paragraph of section 1. The President or his
10 designee may reprogram up to 15 percent to and from the
11 funds appropriated to each of the subsections in section 7.

16 paragraphs within the subsections of section 2.

17 (3) The Chief Justice or his designee may reprogram up
18 to 15 percent to and from the funds appropriated in each of
19 the subsections in section 3.

20 (4) The Public Auditor may reprogram up to 15 percent
21 to and from the funds appropriated in each of the subsections
22 in section 4.

23 (5) Allottees of funds may reprogram up to 15 percent
24 to and from the funds appropriated in each of the paragraphs
25 within the subsections of section 5.

1 (6) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsections (1)
2 through (5) of this section, no funds may be reprogrammed ~~to~~
3 ~~from~~ from any personnel account or funds appropriated pursuant
4 to subparagraph (d) of subsection (1) of section 1, or
5 subparagraphs (b)(v) and (e)(v) of subsection (7) of section
6 1 of this act; PROVIDED, however, that funds may be
7 reprogrammed without limitation from any personnel account in
8 any subsection of section 1 to any other personnel account in
9 such subsection."

10 Section 8. Section 16 of Public Law No. 6-10, as amended by
11 Public Law No. 6-43, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

12 "Section 16. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
13 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
14 managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with
15 applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial
16 Management Act of 1979, as amended; PROVIDED, however, that
17 the allottee of the funds appropriated under subparagraphs
18 (d) and (e) of subsection (1) of section 1 of this act shall
19 be the President and such authority may not be delegated;
20 PROVIDED FURTHER, that the allottees for funds appropriated
21 under subparagraph (m) of subsection (2) of section 12 of
22 this act shall be the Governors of the respective States and
23 that those funds shall not be disbursed from the General Fund
24 to the allottee unless the President certifies that the State
25 involved has entered into a joint law enforcement agreement

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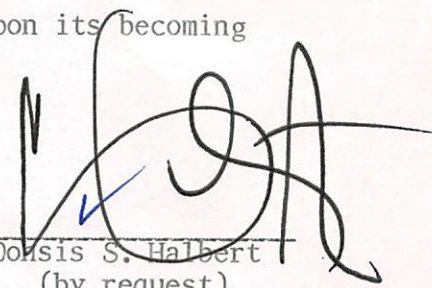

1 for the period of October 1, 1989 to September 30, 1990, with
2 the National Government pursuant to chapter 12 of title 12 of
3 the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia. Each
4 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds,
5 or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for
6 the purposes specified in this act, and that no obligations
7 are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The
8 authority of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by
9 this act shall lapse as of September 30, 1990; PROVIDED,
10 however, that the authority of the allottees to obligate
11 funds appropriated by sections 6, 7, 9, 10, 12(2)(p),
12 12(2)(q) and 13 shall not lapse."

13 Section 9. This act shall become law upon approval by the
14 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
15 law without such approval.
