A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 6-49 by amending sections 1, 2, and 6 to apportion the funds appropriated therein, by amending sections 3 and 5 to change the amount and use of funds appropriated thereunder, by adding new sections 7, 8 and 9, by amending section 7 to change the allottee of certain funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

17 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
18 allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in  
19 accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited  
20 to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee of  
21 the funds appropriated by section 4 of this act shall be  
22 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia ~~and~~.  
23 The allottee of the funds appropriated by subsection (2) of  
24 section 1 of this act shall be the Truk Organization of  
25 Community Action (TOCA); the allottee of the funds

1           appropriated by subsections (4) and (11) of section 1 shall  
2           be the Lower Mortlocks Development Authority; and the  
3           allottee of the funds appropriated by subsections (1), (3),  
4           (5), (6), (7), (8), (9) and (10) shall be the Governor of  
5           Chuuk State. The allottees of the funds appropriated by  
6           sections 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 of this act shall be the  
7           local development authorities of the areas for which the  
8           projects are designated. The allottees shall be  
9           responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much  
10          thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the  
11          purposes specified in this act, and that no obligations are  
12          incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The authority  
13          of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this act  
14          shall not lapse until expended."


15          Section 10. This act shall become law upon approval by the
