AN ACT


To further amend Public Law No. 2-34, as amended, by further amending section 1, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 2-44, 3-12, 3-35, 3-50, 4-79 and 5-11, to change the purpose of the funds appropriated thereby for certain public projects in Chuuk State, and by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 3-17, 4-15, and 5-26, to designate the allottee of a new public project in Chuuk State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1       Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 2-34, as amended by  
2       Public Laws Nos. 2-44, 3-12, 3-35, 3-50, 4-79 and 5-11, is hereby  
3       further amended to read as follows:

4             "Section 1. The sum of \$846,200, or so much thereof as may  
5       be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund  
6       of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year  
7       ending September 30, 1982, for the purpose of funding  
8       certain public projects in the State of Truk. The sum  
9       appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as  
10      follows:
