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A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 5-52, as amended, by further amending sections 1 and 16, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-83, 5-106, 5-127, and 6-4, for the purpose of appropriating the sum of \$227,200 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1989, as supplemental funding for the executive branch; for the purpose of amending the lapse date with respect to funds for Medium-Term Note Program; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 5-52, as amended by Public
2 Laws Nos. 5-83, 5-106, 5-127, and 6-4, is hereby further amended to read
3 as follows:

4 "Section 1. Operating expenses of the executive branch.

5 The sum of ~~\$9,186,147~~ 9,413,347, or so much thereof as may be
6 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
7 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
8 September 30, 1989, for the operations of the executive branch
9 of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia
10 during fiscal year 1989. The sum appropriated by this section
11 shall be apportioned as follows:

18 Section 2. Section 16 of Public Law No. 5-52, as amended by Public Law
 19 No. 6-4, is hereby further amended to read as follows:


20 "Section 16. Allotment and management of funds and lapse date.
 21 All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed,
 22 administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable law,
 23 including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of
 24 1979, as amended; PROVIDED, however, that the allottees for funds
 25 appropriated under subparagraph (p) of subsection (2) of

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1 section 12 shall be the executive directors of the four State
 2 Community Action Agencies, and that those funds shall not be
 3 transferred from the General Fund to any Community Action Agency
 4 until the executive directors have submitted to the Secretary of
 5 Finance a copy of their written agreement regarding the
 6 distribution of funds among the four agencies. Each allottee
 7 shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much
 8 thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purposes
 9 specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in
 10 excess of the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottees to
 11 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of
 12 September 30, 1989; PROVIDED, however, that the authority of the
 13 allottees to obligate funds appropriated by subsection (8) of
 14 section 2, by subparagraph (f) of subsection (1) of section 12,
 15 and by subparagraph (t) of subsection (2) of section 12 shall
 16 lapse as of September 30, 1990, and, PROVIDED FURTHER, that the
 17 authority of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by
 18 subparagraph (e) of subsection (3) of section 1 and by sections 6,
 19 9, 10 and 13 shall not lapse."

20 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the President
 21 of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without
 22 such approval.
