A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$80,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1990, for the purpose of funding the preparation of land for the construction of housing for Australian Naval Advisors to the Pacific Patrol Boat program of the Division of Marine Surveillance of the Federated States of Micronesia, and for other purposes.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The sum of \$80,000, or so much thereof as may be
2 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September
4 30, 1990, for the purpose of funding the preparation of land for the
5 construction of housing for Australian Naval Advisors to the Pacific
6 Patrol Boat program of the Division of Marine Surveillance of the
7 Federated States of Micronesia as provided by a Memorandum of
8 Understanding between the Government of Australia and the Government
9 of the Federated States of Micronesia.

10 Section 2. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
11 allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with
12 applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial
13 Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be the President of the
14 Federated States of Micronesia who shall be responsible for ensuring
15 that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
16 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no
17 obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The
18 authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act
19 shall lapse as of September 30, 1990.

20 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
21 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
22 law without such approval.
